The City Council of the City of Hutchinson, Minnesota, **will receive bids at the Hutchinson City Center, Engineering Office, 111 Hassan St SE, Hutchinson MN, until 10:30 am on Thursday, June 2nd, 2011**, for the making of the following described local improvement:

School Road NW from TH 7/22 to Golf Course Road NW roadway reconstruction, curb and gutter, draitile installation, bituminous/concrete surfacing stormwater/drainage improvements, water distribution/sanitary sewer repairs/upgrades, street lighting, trails/sidewalks, landscaping, restoration and appurtenances;

all in accordance with the Plans and Specifications on file in the City of Hutchinson Engineering Office.

Immediately following expiration of the time for receiving bids, the City Administrator and/or Director of Public Works/City Engineer will publicly open bids, in the Main Conference Room of the Hutchinson City Center. Bids shall be directed to the City Engineer, securely sealed and endorsed upon the outside wrapper.
