THE PURPOSE OF SAID MEETING is to consider the following applications filed with the County Zoning Administrator.

1. A Conditional Use application by Brian Streu for a dog kennel to board and breed up to 30 dogs, 15.22 AC of SE ¼ NW ¼, Sect. 07, Twp. 115-28 (Glencoe.)
