ORDAINS:**

Notice of hearing was duly given and publication of said hearing was duly made and was made to appear to the satisfaction of the City Council that it would be in the best interests of the City to amend the Storm Water Management Ordinance to add language to Chapter 54, General Provisions and add Section 54.05 of the City Code as follows:

**CHAPTER 54**

**STORM WATER MANAGEMENT**

**General Provisions.**

- 54.01 Purpose
- 54.02 Definitions
- 54.03 Scope
- 54.04 Management of Site Vegetation
- 54.05 Use of Stormwater Ponds

**§ 54.05 USE OF STORMWATER  
PONDS**

It will be unlawful for any person to wade, swim or operate any vehicle in or upon the waters of any City stormwater wet pond, or to go upon the frozen surface of any City stormwater wet pond, unless such use is specifically approved in writing by the City Engineer.

**EFFECTIVE DATE OF ORDINANCE.**

This Ordinance shall take effect upon adoption and publication in accordance with the Hutchinson City Charter.
