MIDDLETOWN Senior Midfielder

■ One of the most explosive players in the area, Martin was considered by Knights coach Todd Hawkins to be "irreplaceable."

■ The four-year starter led the Knights with 45 goals and added five assists. Added 185 groundballs and won 83 percent of his faceoffs as the Knights' primary faceoff specialist.
