TUSCARORA Junior Pitcher

■ Her power pitching and hard hitting helped the Titans set a team record for wins with 14 en route to making the Class 3A West Region championship game.

■ Double-digit strikeout games were routine when she pitched. She led the county in strikeouts with 202 in 127 2-3 innings for a county-best 11.1 strikeouts per seven innings pitched. Just as importantly, she only walked 17. Went 12-7 with a 1.15 ERA.

■ As a hitter, she batted .448 with 4 homers and .724 slugging percentage.

■ A quality catcher and offensive threat for one of the county's top teams. She batted a team-high .529 with 12 doubles, 1 triple, 1 homer and 20 RBIs.

■ Tough pitcher who threw 2-plus innings with 2 broken fingers on her throwing hand against Catoctin in the playoffs. Went 13-4 with a 3.15 ERA and 99 Ks in 109 innings. Batted .396 with 4 HRs, 17 RBIs and 17 runs.

■ Made an immediate impact. Her speed allowed her to track down balls with ease in CF. As a leadoff batter, she hit a team-high .474 with 7 doubles, 2 triples, 25 runs and 12 stolen bases.
