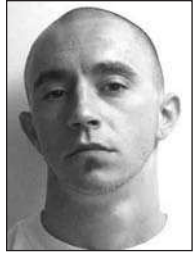

The Ouachita Parish School Board met in regular session on Tuesday, April 28, 2015 at six (6:00) o'clock pm at its regular meeting place, the Ouachita Parish School Board office.

President Hicks called the meeting to order and welcomed visitors and guests to the meeting.

The roll was called and the following members were present: Tommy Comeaux, Scott Robinson, A. R. Sims, Jerry R. Hicks, John Russell, Carey Walker and Greg Manley. There were none absent.

The Pledge of Allegiance to the American Flag was led by Board member Tommy Comeaux.

The Invocation was given by Board member Greg Manley. On motion by Carey Walker, seconded by Greg Manley, the Board unanimously approved the Minutes of April 14, 2015 as written.

Greg Manley moved, seconded by A. R. Sims, that the Board approve the additions and deletion to the Agenda. Motion carried unanimously.

On motion by Scott Robinson, seconded by A. R. Sims, the Board approved the amended Agenda as presented. Motion carried unanimously. Superintendent Webber named the following administrative appointments:

- Principal of Ouachita Parish High School – Eddie Mahoney (12 Mo.) effective 6/01/15
- Director of Middle Schools – Werner Aswell (12 Mo.) effective 6/01/15

On the recommendation of Dr. Webber, A. R. Sims moved, seconded by Carey Walker, that the Board approve opening the following positions for application:

- Woodlawn Elementary Principal

- Central Elementary Assistant Principal
- Calhoun Middle School Principal
- Ouachita High School Assistant Principal

Motion carried unanimously. Business Director Juanita Duke informed the Board that prior to spring break, Office of Group Benefits (OGB) issued a notice that insurance premiums would be increasing, but only on the Blue Cross/Blue Shield plans administered by OGB, not the Vantage HMO plan. The amount of the increase will vary, depending on the plan enrolled. In total there are 3,143 members active and retirees who participate in the group health insurance benefit plans that are offered through the school system via State of Louisiana through the Office of Group Benefits. The highest rate increase of 12% is going to be applied to the Magnolia Local Plus plan. This will result in a 12% across the board rate increase, which will be effective on July 1, 2015. Our premiums are paid in advance; therefore, the increase will affect June payroll checks for our employees. There are four plans currently available to our employees through Office of Group Benefits and Blue Cross/Blue Shield: Magnolia Open Access; Magnolia Local Plus; Pelican HRA and Pelican HSA (Mrs. Duke provided a chart for the Board that lists the rate increases for each plan slated to go into effect July 1, 2015). Over 50% of our active employees are enrolled in the Magnolia Local Plus plan and around 16% of our retirees are enrolled in this plan. After looking at all the memberships and the distribution of premiums for all retirees and active employees and when computing this information it is on average about a 10% across the board increase whenever all plans are averaged and looked at together including costs in what we are anticipating this next year. The overall increase in cost of the group health plan will be approximately \$2 million or a 10% increase. Mrs. Duke reminded the Board this increase will be a factor to take into consideration in preparing the 2015-16 budget for next year.

On the recommendation of Business Director Juanita Duke, Carey Walker moved, seconded by A. R. Sims, that the Board adopt the Resolution urging state senators and state representatives to find alternative measures in balancing the state budget without reducing or repealing the inventory tax that local governments rely on for its operations.

The following roll call vote was recorded: Tommy Comeaux, yes; Scott Robinson, yes; A. R. Sims, yes; Jerry Hicks, yes; John Russell, yes; Carey Walker, yes; Greg Manley, yes. Motion carried, with seven "yes" votes and no "nay" votes.

On the recommendation of Purchasing Agent Bobby Jones, Mr. Sims moved, seconded by Scott Robinson, that the Board grant permission to install new replacement security cameras at West Ouachita High School with cost not to exceed \$130,000 and paid with West Ouachita Sales Tax funds. Motion carried unanimously.

On the recommendation of Board attorney Elmer Noah, Greg Manley moved, seconded by Tommy Comeaux, that the Board adopt the Cooperative Endeavor Agreement between the Ouachita Parish Police Jury ("OPPJ") and the Ouachita Parish School Board (OPSB) for the purpose of giving the OPPJ the right to install a water well and have access to the well located on the old Logtown School property. With the additional water well installation, the OPPJ has determined that the development of wells and water storage tanks will increase the availability of water for fire-fighting purposes and thereby promote public safety, improve the OPPJ's fire rating requirements, aid the OPFD's ratings, and benefit the owners of insured property in the OPFD area. Motion carried unanimously.

Purchasing Agent Bobby Jones alerted the Board that he may have to ask the Board's permission to purchase two more temporary buildings due to growth at Sterlington and Claiborne Elementary Schools at the next meeting. Right now he is getting ready to move three t-buildings to Sterlington and two T-Buildings to Claiborne Elementary Schools. However, after surveying the condition of the T-Buildings, Mr. Jones says he may not be able to move some of them. Mr. Jones just wanted to prepare the Board, in case there is a need to purchase additional t-buildings for these two schools. If it is necessary to purchase two t-buildings, one will go to Sterlington and the other to Claiborne.

On the recommendation of Special Projects/Safety Coordinator Kenneth Slusher, Greg Manley moved, seconded by Carey Walker, that the Board grant permission to get quotes in June for resurfacing the driveway and small parking lot located beside the school at Sterlington Middle School after the weight room project is finished. Motion carried unanimously.

Special Projects/Safety Coordinator Kenneth Slusher reported on two Eastside projects under construction, OPHS Lecture Hall and Weight Room at Sterlington Middle School. There has been so much rain, construction progress has been slow. Mr. Slusher wouldn't say that the contractors were behind schedule, but they are going to be if the rain doesn't let up.

On the recommendation of Special Projects/Safety Coordinator Kenneth Slusher, A. R. Sims moved, seconded by Scott Robinson, to appoint Rice Gregory the architect for construction of the additional classroom wing at West Ouachita High School.

Mr. Sims and Robinson withdrew their motions to appoint Rice Gregory the architect for the additional classroom wing at West Ouachita High School so it can be placed on the agenda May 12.

On the recommendation of Special Projects/Safety Coordinator Kenneth Slusher, Carey Walker moved, seconded by Greg Manley, that the Board accept the low bid meeting specifications from Mann Construction in the amount of \$16,825,000 with a budget of \$17,000,000 and funded through Eastside Bonds [Bid No. 41-15]. Motion carried unanimously.

On the recommendation of Purchasing Agent Bobby Jones, Scott Robinson moved, seconded by Tommy Comeaux, that the Board approve the low bid and only bid from Mechanical Concepts for Boilers/Air Handlers and paid with General Fund A/C account for: Item 1 (Good Hope) \$12,000; Item 2 (Kiroli) \$11,447; Item 3 (OJHS) \$10,158 [Bid No. 43-15]. Motion carried unanimously.

On the recommendation of Purchasing Agent Bobby Jones, Greg Manley moved, seconded by Scott Robinson, that the Board accept the bid meeting specifications from Irby for Item 1 (\$95.50) and Item 2 (365.00) to be paid from Westside Sales Tax funds [Bid No. 45-15]. Motion carried unanimously.

On the recommendation of Special Projects/Safety Coordinator Kenneth Slusher, Greg Manley moved, seconded by Carey Walker, that the Board grant permission to bid the construction of a pavilion at Jack Hayes Elementary with a budget of \$140,000 and paid with Eastside Bonds [Bid No. 48-15].
