He indicated that those funds reflecting a projected deficit will utilize their respective fund balances to cover those losses. The overall Consolidated Budget reflected revenues in the amount of \$48,194,122, expenditures in the amount of \$49,651,850 with an overall deficiency in the amount of \$1,457,728. The budget once again provides for extended personnel supplements, several minor capital projects and a renewed technology enhancement program. He noted that the general fund and the special revenue funds, of Sales Tax 80% Sales Tax 60%, are reflecting a deficiency. Mr. O'Neal indicated that although a deficiency is noted in the Debt Service Funds, that it should be considered a positive thing as they are being brought about as a result of forward funding during a previous accounting period. In the absence of solicited comments and input from the general public, it was moved by Mr. Bradford, seconded by Mr. Raven and carried unanimously to adjourn at 6:21 p.m.
