STATEMENT BY CHANCELOR CALDWELL:

This is a day of deep tragedy for our Nation and mankind. Let not the playing of this game tonight diminish our sense of respect for our great departed President and the office.

President Tribble of Wake Forest joins me in this request: that those present and all who hear us join in one minute of silent prayer for the United States of America and the welfare of all mankind, at the conclusion of which I shall read the last stanza of our National Anthem, followed by its presentation by the combined bands.

Will you please rise and pray silently.

I have been asked to explain why we went ahead with the playing of our football game tonight in the midst of our deep national tragedy.

First, the game would be played now or later and our sense of respect for the President would, I hope, not later be diminished ~~xxx~~ or our grief assuaged. To play ~~x~~ it now means a vast saving in time and money for ~~many~~ many people.

Second, I learned that our players desired to play the game as scheduled.

Third, I deeply believe that President Kennedy would have wished the game to go on.

Fourth, the decision was not a simple one for me, though it might seem so for anyone else not charged with the responsibility to make it.

Fifth, we have seized the opportunity to pay our respect and pray solemnly for our country and our fellow men everywhere.

Sixth, no one who felt a compulsion to stay at home or ignore the event was prevented from following his own conscience.

POST GAME QUOTES, N.C. STATE VS. WAKE FOREST.

EARLE EDWARDS:

"The fast start helped us with the game. Wake Forest got down after that. I believe Wake Forest had a letdown after last week.

"We had a great bit at stake. I think the boys knew it. We haven't been Conference champions too often you know.

"We are real proud to share it (ACC title). It is too much to ask for a tie out of the Duke-Carolina game. We had a real good season.

"It was too bad that Tony (Koszarsky) couldn't play tonight. He's been a good ^{off}

Asked to compare this to 1957 team: "It is a better squad from the standpoint of depth. It's really not fair to compare them. Both had outstanding individuals and gave 100% effort.

We blocked well, but that depends against who you play. We did do a lot of things well.

Asked about how President Kennedy's death effected the squad. "We have to carry on in a situation like this. It was a ~~xxxx~~ tragedy of the first magnitude and a senseless waste of a great person."

COACH BILLY HILDEBRAND: "There's not much I can say. We were up last week, but this week we weren't."

"State is a mighty fine ball club. They had much better speed than I realized. They brought the fight right to us at the beginning. They were charged upx since they were fighting for a championship--and they now have a share of it.

"State is one of the best clubs we have faced all season.

"Our boys kep fighting, but they just couldn't cope with the play of State.

WINSTON-SALEM, N. C. -- Wake Forest, the shackles of an 18-game losing streak now broken, will be seeking to close out the 1963 season on a successful note Friday night against N. C. State in Riddick Stadium.

The rejuvenated Deacons, still basking in the spotlight following their 20-19 victory over South Carolina last week, can become real spoilers in State's bid for a share of the ACC championship. The Wolfpack needs a win to be assured of at least a tie for the conference crown.

Deacon Coach Billy Hildebrand is hoping his club can continue to play the same type of ball both offensively and defensively as it did in the second half against South Carolina. After being outclassed in the first half, the Deacs came back to completely dominate play in the final two quarters.

In the second half the Deacs rolled up 204 yards in total offense while limiting the Gamecocks to just one yard. The second half rushing total of 183 yards was far better than anything the Deacs have done previously in a full game this fall.

"If we can put together a full game like the second half against South Carolina then Friday night's game should be a real battle," Hildebrand said.

The Deacs also hope fullback Brian Piccolo can have as much success running against the Wolfpack as he did last week. Piccolo enjoyed the best day of his college career with 140 yards in 21 attempts. In addition he caught one pass for 12 yards, and capped the afternoon off by kicking the all-important extra point which provided the final margin of victory.

The Ft. Lauderdale, Fla., junior has already carried the ball as many times as he did in 10 games last season, and has gained more yardage. Last year he carried 77 times for 324 yards and a 4.2 average. Going into Friday night's game he has carried 77 times for 347 yards and a 4.5 average.
