

CONCEPT OF OPERATIONS: (FULLY OPERATIONAL-No Impact / REDUCED- extended wait times & SHUTDOWN-CLOSED)

- **Directorate of Aviation Operations:**

- **OPERATIONAL:**

- 24 hours/7 days a week Air Traffic Control services at Robert Grey Army Airfield
- 16 hours/5 days a week Air Traffic Control services at Hood Army Airfield
- 24 hours/7days a week Navigational Aid maintenance support
- 16 hours/7 days a week base operations services

- **REDUCED:** 7 hours/5 days a week to minimal support for airfield operations at both airfields

- **SHUT DOWN:** Aviation simulation training

- **Directorate of Emergency Services:**

- **OPERATIONAL: (No Major impact)**

- Command and control for emergency management response of police and fire operations to include emergency 911 dispatching
- Provide emergency response services for structure fires and installation wild-land fires, aircraft rescue fire fighting, hazardous materials and chemical, biological, radiological, nuclear and high-yield explosives incidents.

 - Military construction projects
 - **SHUTDOWN:**
 - Priority 2/3 service orders
 - Copeland Center in/out processing for off-post housing
 - Dig permits
 - Classification Unit closed and Environmental Services (fuel tank purging, MKT cleaning, etc.)
 - FSBP support

- **OPERATIONAL:**
 - Business Division: All facilities operational.
 - Child, Youth & School Services Division: All facilities operational.
