Clearly, the Lewis-Clark State Warriors aren't lacking for motivation this season.

Gary Picone, in his second year as L-C coach, is confident in his club as it begins pursuit of the school's 17th national title today in a tournament at Phoenix. The pitching staff has been revamped and the lineup has been augmented with newcomers capable of playing at numerous positions and hitting from either side of the plate.

The Warriors' schedule also appears to be an upgrade over previous slates. The highlight is probably the spring-break visit that fellow NAIA stalwart Embry-Riddle of Florida will make to Lewiston for a four-game set with L-C in late March.
