



Personally appear before me, one Detective Jeff Cauble who, being duly sworn, says that there is probable cause to believe that certain property subject to seizure under provisions of Section 17-13-140, 1976 Code of Laws of South Carolina, as amended, is located on the following premises in this County:

Any and all cell phones and their content, computers, to include hard drives, video recording devices and their content, digital storage devices and their content, blood and other bodily fluids, weapons, clothing, jewelry, phone records, audio recording devices and their content, bank records, negotiable instruments, securities, check books, deposit slips, money storage and transfer methods, vehicle keys, receipts, and personal identification, correspondence, passwords and any and all garden tools, and or outdoor tools.

**DESCRIPTION OF PREMISES (PERSON, PLACE OR THING)  
TO BE SEARCHED**

Property is located and identified on Horry County Tax map # 1700005004 as shown on the attached (A). This property contains two residences specifically identified as 8786 Hwy. 814 and 8796 Hwy. 814 in the Myrtle Beach section of Horry County. The residences are described as follows: One being a brick two story residence with white siding. The second being a single level orange in color dwelling. There is a white fence around the residence. See attached (A). The property to be searched also includes out-buildings and a detached garage, vehicles and any other storage containers as well as the curtilage of the described property herein.

**REASON FOR AFFIANT'S BELIEF THAT THE  
PROPERTY SOUGHT IS ON THE SUBJECT PREMISES**

On December 20<sup>th</sup>, 2013 Horry County Police Department initiated an investigation on a missing female after the family reported that she had been missing for two days. Through the victims phone records it was determined that the last contact the victim made was with a cell phone identified as Sidney Moorers, who resides on the property described above. This property is approximately 3.8 miles from the last known location, Peachtree Boat Landing, of the victim's cell phone and her vehicle. During an interview with Sidney Moorers, he admitted having a relationship with the victim and talking with her shortly before all cell phone usage by the victim stopped in the early morning hours of December 18<sup>th</sup>, 2013.

Tammy Moorers, also a resident of the above described property, provided a statement that indicated she was with her husband at all times on the night of December 17<sup>th</sup> and early morning hours of December 18<sup>th</sup>. Sidney Moorers had also indicated he could not leave the home without his wife because of trust issues and that both were at their residence in the early morning hours of December 18<sup>th</sup>, 2013.

Two private surveillance camera videos were obtained from locations along the route between the herein described property and Peachtree Boat Landing. See attached (B). Both videos were enhanced and analyzed by vehicle identification experts. The video captures a


