

Glow-in-the-Dark



Supplies:

Elmer's Glue-All (The clear kind, NOT school glue)
Liquid starch
Glow-in-the-dark craft paint

Step 1: Pour 1/4 cup of liquid starch into a disposable cup or bowl. Stir in 1-2 tablespoons of glow-in-the-dark paint (a craft stick works well).

Step 2: Stir in 1/4 cup glue; mix well.

Step 3: Place the slime on a few layers of paper towel to dry, patting with more towels to absorb the excess moisture. (There will also be liquid left in the cup).

Step 4: Once the moisture is absorbed, squish and squeeze the mixture with your hands. It will be very stringy and messy at first, but keep squishing! It'll get there. Run under clear water and keep working it with your fingers until it attains a rubbery consistency
Store in an airtight container.

Note: A full-spectrum UV light works fastest and best to “recharge” the slime’s glow (although any
