How the survey was conducted:

The results of this poll are based on 694 interviews, of which 430 were landline telephone and 263 were cell phone, conducted September 18-24, 2013 of residents of the city of Richmond, and Henrico, Chesterfield, and Hanover counties. The margin of error for the whole survey is +/- 3.72% at the 95% level of confidence. The margin of error for individual localities will be higher. In addition to sampling error, the other potential sources of error include non-response, question wording, and interviewer error. The response rate (AAPOR RRI Standard Definition) for the survey was 23%. Five callbacks were employed in the fielding process. Live calling was conducted by trained interviewers at the Wason Center for Public Policy Survey Research Lab at Christopher Newport University. The data reported here are weighted using an iterative weighting process on sex, age, race and location of residence to reflect as closely as possible the demographic composition of the region. The survey was designed by Dr. Quentin Kidd of the Wason Center for Public Policy at Christopher Newport University.
