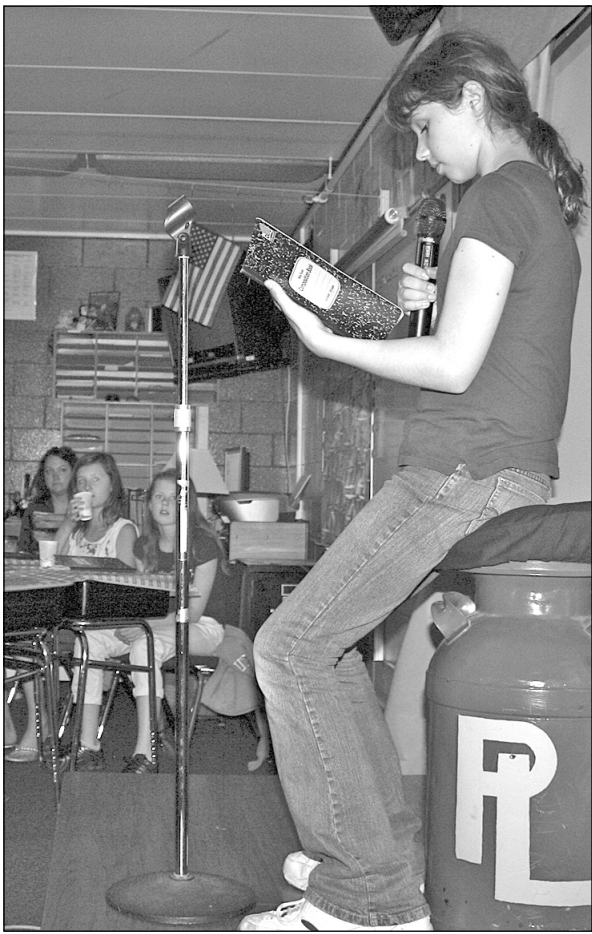

Nagarajan receives National Merit Scholarship

Prior Lake High School senior Max Nagarajan has been awarded the National Merit University of Minnesota Scholarship.

Nagarajan, of Prior Lake, was named along with more than 2,900 other students as recipients of various National Merit Scholarships on Wednesday. He plans to attend the University of Minnesota-Twin Cities to study medicine.

The National Merit Scholarship is the culmination of a long process. More than 1.5 million juniors in over 22,000 high

schools entered the 2011 National Merit Scholarship Competition. Students first took the 2009 Preliminary SAT/National Merit Scholarship Qualifying Test (PSAT/NMSQT).

The students were then narrowed to 16,000 semifinalists – who had to apply for finalist status by submitting academic records, recommendations and SAT scores – last fall. More than 15,000 semifinalists were named finalists, and more than half of them will win merit scholarships.

In 2009, Colton broke his right leg just above his ankle while practicing a 180-bunny-hop stoppie. The first serious injury of his career put him on the sidelines for several months.

"Obviously, in a sport of this nature, injuries happen, and they happen frequently," Colton said in a November 2009 RedBullUSA.com article. "I've broken ribs and bones in my hand before and had some sprains, but nothing like this where the doctor's telling me that it's going to take five or six months to recover and get range of motion back."

The injury made Colton more determined to come back in "the best physical shape of his life" for 2010. He used a hardcore training regimen to get him back competitively and is feeling better than ever.

"Everything is getting bigger and bigger and bigger, and I think this upcoming year is really going to be huge for me," he said.

Recently, Colton has also gotten into motorcycle road racing during his down time. While he's not looking to crossover, Colton sees racing as a complement to his freestyle riding.

In recent years, street bike freestyle has shed much of its "bad-boy image." Colton has been at the front of that transition by adding credibility to the sport. He hopes one day to be counted among extreme sport athletes like Shaun White and Tony Hawk.

He'll get his chance this summer when freestyle rid-

ing joins the X-Games. After last summer's demo series, the extreme games decided to make it a non-televized event, according to Colton.

Colton will also be back on the second season of the "Inside XDL" reality series, which follows freestyle sportbike riders on the premier, five-event championship point series. Last year, Colton finished 11th in the XDL. His next 2011 event is June 9-11 in Nashville, Tenn.

Touring is a full-time job for Colton and he's become

pretty good at it – always having his camera, laptop, clothes backpack and gear bag ready to move.

He's missed out on the typical high school experience since his schedule forced him

to finish high school online instead of graduating with his Shakopee classmates last year.

"But I wouldn't give up what I'm doing for anything," he said.
