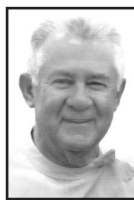

CHOLESTEROL-LOWERING DRUGS MAY BENEFIT SMOKERS

Many Americans derive benefit from the group of cholesterol-lowering drugs collectively known as "statins," such as Lipitor, Pravachol, and Zocor. Now it seems that the smokers among them may gain additional health benefits. According to a recent study, statins may improve the lung health of both smokers and former smokers. One of these benefits is that statin-takers who are or were smokers saw less of a decline in their ability to expel air from their lungs than (former) smokers who did not take statins. Patients with a serious condition called obstructive lung disease had less need to be hospitalized or visit emergency rooms after taking statin drugs. The benefit may stem from statins' ability to reduce inflammation in airways.

The best thing to do if you smoke is to quit. The health benefits of quitting are numerous, and quitting really should be everyone's goal. Two detectives still working home invasion
