

Kenny Loggins to sing at Hazeltine's celebration

Hazeltine National National Golf Club is celebrating its 50th anniversary with a weekend of star-studded events Sept. 7-8.

Hazeltine National, located in Chaska, has hosted some of the biggest tournaments in golf throughout the years, having hosted two U.S. Opens, two PGA Championships, the U.S. Senior Open, two U.S. Women's Opens and the U.S. Amateur Championship.

It has hosted more U.S. Golf Association (USGA) events than any other golf club in the United States. Hazeltine National is also preparing to host the 2016 Ryder Cup Matches, bringing the top golfers in the United States and Europe to Minnesota.

"When you look at the list of the championships that Hazeltine has been fortunate enough to host in just 50 years, it's really quite a remarkable achievement," stated Reed Mackenzie, former president of the USGA and former Hazeltine National president, in a Hazeltine press release. "It was

started to be a club for golfers to enjoy a quality course and golfing experience and to serve as a venue for local, regional and national championships. It has achieved both goals, but particularly excelled as a tour-

name venue."

The 50th anniversary celebration will be a star-studded affair. Among those attending will include 1970 U.S. Open champion Tony Jacklin and Minnesota Gov. Mark Dayton, who will attend Friday night's Legacy Event, honoring Hazeltine's rich history. Grammy winner Kenny Loggins will perform a live concert Saturday during the 50th Anniversary Celebration.

- Friday, Sept. 7, 7 p.m.: 50th Anniversary Legacy Event; 2-Day Golf Tournament
- Saturday, Sept. 8, 6:30 p.m.: 50th Anniversary Celebration featuring live concert by Grammy Award winner Kenny Loggins

Chaska residents are being invited to the Saturday concert. The cost is \$150 per person and includes an 'around the world' dinner, the private concert, and a gift. Hazeltine will be limited the number of attendees, so first-come, first-served. Register by calling Ashley Beattie at (952)

"We are rolling out the red carpet for the 50th anniversary celebration at Hazeltine," said Jim Anderson, Hazeltine board member and co-chair of the anniversary committee. "The weekend of events will look back at 50 years of world-class golf and our community and celebrate all that we've accomplished."

Famed golf course architect Robert Trent Jones designed Hazeltine's award-winning course in 1962. The course and clubhouse underwent a \$15 million transformation in 2010 and 2011.

The 20-month project updated the golf course, built a brand new clubhouse with more than 50,000 square feet of meeting and event space and created a new Golf Learning Center and practice facility.

The golf course at Hazeltine National is reserved for private members and their guests, but several golf and social opportunities are available to the public.

RILEY PURGATORY BLUFF CREEK WATERSHED DISTRICT BOARD OF MANAGERS NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING LOTUS LAKE LOW IMPACT DEVELOPMENT PILOT PROJECTS

PLEASE TAKE NOTICE that the Board of Managers of the Riley Purgatory Bluff Creek Watershed District will hold a public hearing on the Lotus Lake Low Impact Development Pilot Projects at 7:00 p.m., September 19, 2012, in Eden Prairie City Hall, Heritage Room, 8080 Mitchell Road, in Eden Prairie, Minnesota.

As described in the District's Third Generation Water Management Plan, the purpose of the Low Impact Development (LID) program is to provide assistance to residents of the District for implementation of infiltration projects. The program is aimed at improving the management of stormwater runoff and related sources of impairment through collaborative efforts to design projects and share the costs.

Through a combination of technical assessment and citizen outreach, the District has identified pilot projects on six residential properties in the Carver Beach neighborhood on the northwest side of Lotus Lake in Chanhassen, MN. These pilot projects involve the installation of drainage swales and rain gardens, and will serve as neighborhood demonstrations and provide measurable reductions in stormwater runoff, sediment and phosphorus draining into Lotus Lake. The District will utilize the information and experience gained through these pilot projects to guide further development of the LID Program.

The total estimated construction cost for the six pilot projects is \$110,000. Each of the six property owners will contribute a permanent

easement for the project site, and also commit to provide all necessary maintenance activities over a period of 15-20 years, depending upon the particular project.

The District proposes to pay for the estimated \$110,000 construction cost through its ad valorem property tax levy authorized by Minnesota Statutes Section 103B.241 for the implementation of its water management plan. Approximately 76.8% of this levy will be paid by properties in Hennepin County, and 23.2% paid by properties in Carver County.

All interested parties are invited to appear at the public hearing to offer comments and ask questions in order to advise the board of managers on whether to approve the proposed pilot projects. 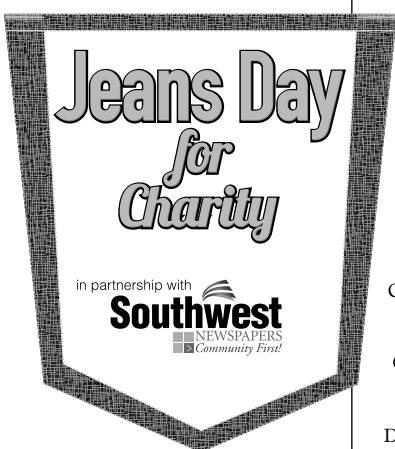
