That Chapter 2, Article II, Division 2: Mayor and Council Sec. 2-31. Terms of Mayor and Council Members.

The term for the office of mayor shall be two four years beginning January 2013, and the terms for the offices of councilmembers shall be four year Two councilmembers shall be elected for four year terms at each biennial city election.

This ordinance shall become effective upon its passage in accordance with Section 1-10.5 (c).
