
On Wall Street



Stocks end bumpy day slightly lower

NEW YORK (AP) — U.S. stocks extended their three-day losing streak Tuesday, closing slightly lower after spending most of the day wavering between gains and losses.

Energy companies led the decline as the price of U.S. crude oil sank nearly 6 percent. It's now at about \$28 a barrel. The market's bumpy ride followed a slide in European stock indexes and steep losses in Japan, reflecting mounting investor anxiety that

the global economy is slowing. The Dow Jones industrial average fell 12.67 points, or 0.1 percent, to 16,014.38. The Standard & Poor's 500 slipped 1.23 0.1points, or percent, 1,852.21. The Nasdag composite lost 14.99 points, or 0.4 percent, to 4,268.76.
