




ORDER DIRECTING ANSWER AND GRANTING STAY

This original petition for a writ of mandamus and/or prohibition challenges respondent's, the Nevada Commission on Judicial Discipline (the Commission), jurisdiction over a complaint filed regarding petitioner, Justice of the Peace Michelle Fiore. Having reviewed the petition and supporting documents, this court concludes that an answer may assist in resolving this matter. Therefore, respondent shall have 28 days from the date of this order within which to file and serve an answer, including authorities, against issuance of the requested writ. NRAP 21(b)(1). Petitioner shall have 14 days from service of the answer to file and serve any reply.


Petitioner has also filed an emergency motion to stay the underlying proceedings before the Commission pending the resolution of the writ petition. Having considered the motion and the relevant factors, we conclude that a stay is warranted. NRAP 8(c). Accordingly, we grant the

emergency motion and stay the proceedings before the Commission pending further order of this court.

It is so ORDERED.
