**WHEREAS,** the Inter-Tribal Council of Nevada, Inc. (“ITCN”) is a nonprofit tribal organization formed under the laws of the State of Nevada on February 23, 1966, and organized and operated in accordance with its Articles of Incorporation filed on February 23, 1966 and its First Amended and Restated Bylaws adopted on December 17, 2019; and

**WHEREAS,** the purpose of ITCN is stated in the First Amended and Restated Bylaws adopted on December 17, 2019; and

**WHEREAS,** ITCN operates for the benefit of its twenty-seven (28) Member Tribes and their people; and

**WHEREAS,** ITCN’s Board of Directors (“the Board”) is comprised of one elected representative from each of ITCN’s twenty-seven (28) Member Tribes; and

**WHEREAS,** the Inter-Tribal Council of Nevada has a continuing interest in the health, education, and well-being of their Indian people; and

**WHEREAS,** ITCN serves as the tribal consortium Head Start grantee for several Nevada Tribes; and

**WHEREAS,** ITCN has engaged in federal monitoring and Tribal Government Consultation related to its Head Start program; and

**WHEREAS,** ITCN has demonstrated corrective action, fiscal recovery, and active governance oversight; and

**WHEREAS,** federal regulation at 45 CFR § 1304.14 provides that Tribal Government Consultation is intended to support corrective action and continued program operation, and does not mandate relinquishment or termination where compliance is demonstrated; and

**WHEREAS,** the March 2024 Office of Head Start correspondence expressly contemplates non-competitive renewal upon demonstration of full compliance;

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED,** that the ITCN Executive Board authorizes ITCN leadership to evaluate potential contingency options, including voluntary relinquishment, only if federal authorities decline to acknowledge corrected documentation and demonstrated compliance, and only upon further express approval of the Board.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED**, that this Resolution does not constitute approval of relinquishment, does not waive any rights of ITCN or its Member Tribes, and expressly preserves tribal authority over any future decisions regarding Head Start services.

This resolution does not constitute approval of relinquishment and preserves tribal authority over any future decisions.
