### **Trinity County Releases Final Public Review Draft Community Plans**

**Weaverville, CA (December 04, 2025)** – Trinity County today announced the release of the [Final Public Review Draft Community Plans](#), marking a significant milestone in the development of the Trinity County General Plan 2050. The overall schedule remains on track, with final General Plan adoption scheduled for late 2026.

The updated draft plans incorporate public comments recommended for inclusion by the Trinity County Board of Supervisors and Planning Commission following the General Plan Study Sessions held in June 2025. They also reflect community feedback gathered during the September 2025 community workshops, as well as additional comments submitted via email and on the project website after the June meetings.

The Trinity County General Plan 2050 serves as the County's long-range "blueprint" for future growth and development. Once adopted, it will guide decision-making across a wide range of topics, including land use, health and safety, and natural resource conservation.

The third chapter of the General Plan—referred to as an "Element"—contains eight community plans crafted to address the unique needs and priorities of individual communities across Trinity County on issues such as (but not limited to):

- Land Use
- Unique Environmental Features
- Hazards and Safety
- Public Facilities

When adopted, the updated countywide General Plan and the individual community plans will work together to guide future development, ensuring that both countywide goals and

community-specific objectives are achieved. All community plans are fully aligned with the overarching goals and policies of the General Plan.
