TRAFFIC CONTROL NOTICE – CITY OF REDDING CIP

Capital Improvement Projects (CIPs) are large, long-term investments the City of Redding makes to build, maintain, or improve infrastructure and public facilities. This is a City of Redding Project.

PROJECT: Turtle Bay to Downtown Gap Completion

LOCATION: Sundial Bridge Drive Between Highway 44 and Aoki Way

WHEN: February 11, 2026 through February 27, 2026

WHAT: Street Traffic Control

WHY: This project closes a critical gap in the shared-use path system that links downtown Redding to the Sundial Bridge and the regional trail network. Beyond the strategic use of grant funding, the project delivers meaningful community benefits to residents and visitors alike, including increased safety, improved accessibility, and enhanced experience for the tens of thousands of people who use the Sundial Bridge, Civic Auditorium area, and surrounding trails each year.

Sundial Bridge Drive and the parking lot east of the Civic Auditorium will be subject to traffic control and parking restrictions.

The work will take place between the hours of 7:00am and 5:00pm. During the traffic closure, the contractor will be installing new sidewalk and pedestrian facilities, as well as new pathway lighting.

Emergency Service vehicles will be allowed access during work hours.

In this and all construction zones, please drive with caution, follow all signs and/or detours, or avoid the area entirely if possible.
