Firefighters have identified remaining heat on Log Fire

Aerial observation after recent rain showed two remaining heat sources on the Log Fire. One is along Salt Log Creek, wedged between the Hancock and McCash burn scars where fuels are sparse. As of Saturday's flight, it showed no smoke or significant heat and spread remains unlikely. The second source is near Rock Creek, where the fire made a small run before the rain. This heat is smoldering inside a snag in rocky terrain with patchy vegetation, posing little risk of spread. It also showed no smoke or additional heat on Saturday.

Air resources will continue daily flyovers to monitor for changes. The fire received light rain early this morning from a passing cold front. While weaker than the earlier storm, it may still help moderate fire activity. Winds also shifted to come from the northwest with the front.
