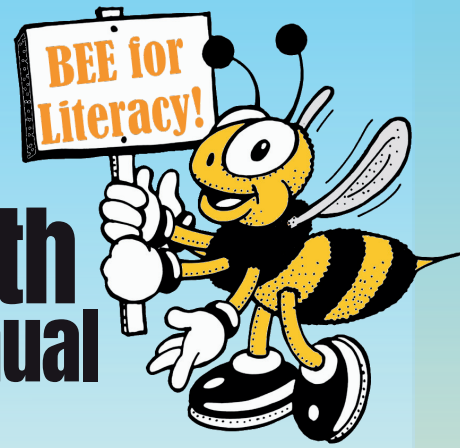

The Buzz...

Each team consists of **three members**. Teams
are given **20 seconds** after each question to
confer and write down their final answer. **One
point** is given for each correct answer; there
are no penalties for wrong answers. There are
three rounds, and each new round starts at
zero. The **Qualifying Round** consists of 30
questions. The ten teams with the highest score
will compete in the **Semi-Final Round** of 15
questions. The **Final Round** for the top five
teams will have a total of 7 questions. In the
event of a tie, a **"Sudden Death"** tie-breaker
will take place.

It's never too late to learn! The heart of Butte County Library Literacy Services is the **Adult Reading Program.**

Adults interested in improving their basic reading and writing skills are matched with trained volunteers from the community. Pairs work towards the adult learner's goals which may range from getting a better job to being able to read a bedtime story to his/her child.



English language learners can drop in on our English as a Second Language conversation groups to practice English listening and speaking skills in a friendly small group environment. Groups are offered in Chico, Oroville, and Gridley.



Career Online High School (COHS) offers adults the opportunity to earn a free accredited high school diploma and a career certificate.

The Mobile Library is a 36' custom-built vehicle that travels throughout Butte County sharing intentional early literacy experiences for Family Literacy Services as well as offering the Library's Bookmobile services.
