NOTICE OF STREET WORK

SUBJECT: OLD OREGON TRAIL SHOULDER WIDENING PROJECT

LOCATION: Old Oregon Trail from Paso Robles Avenue to Bear Mountain Road.

Portions of the following street(s) will be subject to street closures, lane closures and detours:

- Old Oregon Trail Road from Paso Robles Avenue to Bear Mountain Road.

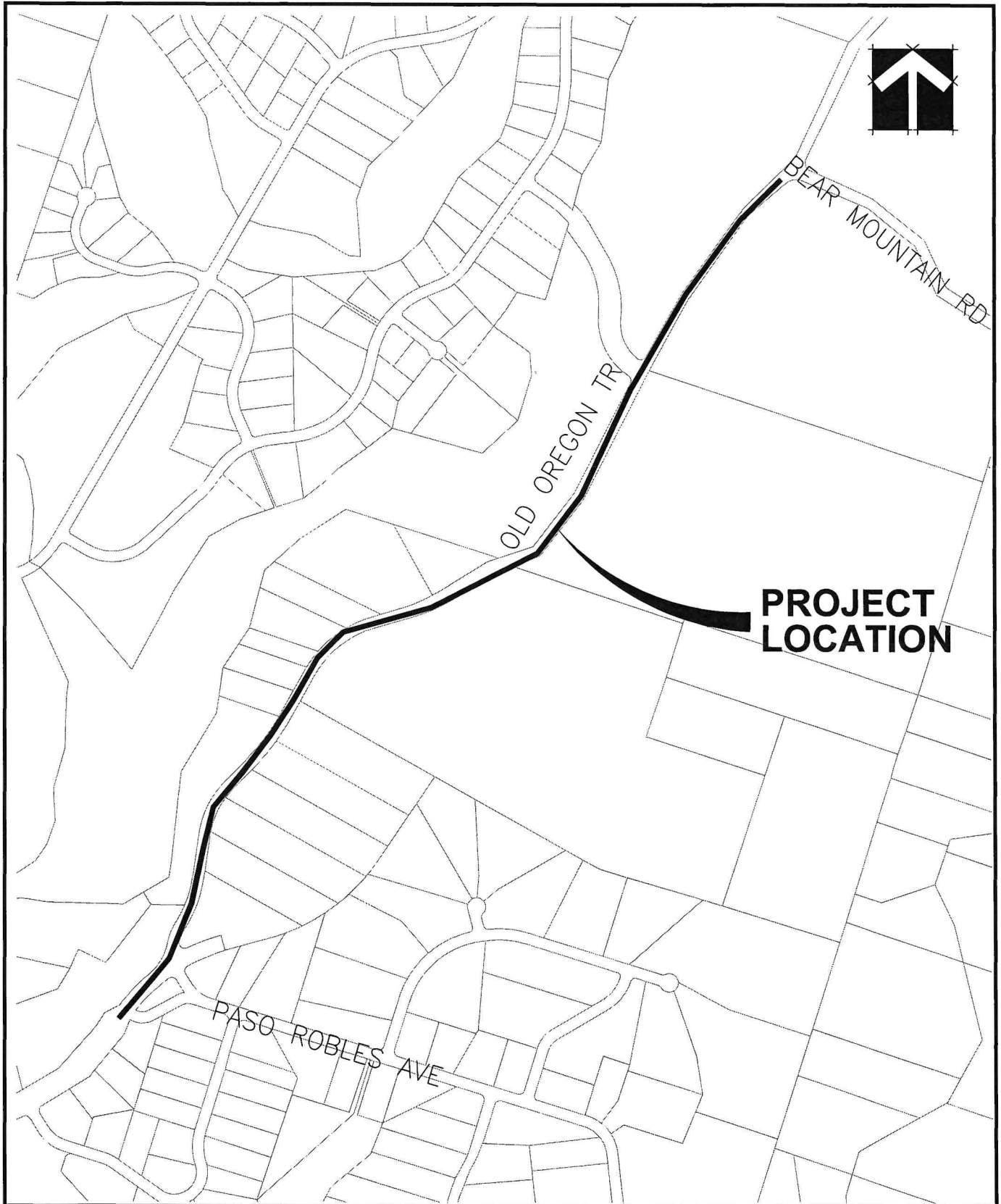
The project construction for the Old Oregon Trail Shoulder Widening Project will recommence work starting on Monday, May 27, 2025 and is expected to be completed on or before August 29, 2025. During the construction, the work will take place between the hours of 7:00 a.m. and 5:00 p.m., Monday through Friday. During the work hours, portions of the street will be limited to one-way traffic and the use of flaggers and a piolet car for the traveling public to follow safely through the work zone with some delays around 15 minutes and a maximum delay of potentially 20 minutes through this area. It is important to note that during construction, it is anticipated that portions of the roadway will have the existing asphalt removed and the traveling public will need to drive slowly upon the temporary road surface through this area for a potential duration of up to three weeks. The work that involves driving off of paved areas is expected to start on or after June 2, 2025

During these traffic closures, the contractor will be installing new storm drain piping, storm drain area drains, relocating water services, relocating fire hydrants, placing a new roadway section for a curve correction as well as geometric improvements including widening the roadway shoulders along both sides of the road from Paso Robles Avenue to Bear Mountain Road.

The City of Redding wishes to advise all motorists to drive with caution when approaching these areas or avoid them if possible by using alternates routes.

Emergency Services vehicles will be allowed access unless otherwise noted.
