### SUMMARY:

On Tuesday, November 19, 2024, at approximately 7:08 PM, Officers from the Red Bluff Police Department responded to the 900 block of Walnut Street for a report of a vehicle versus pedestrian collision.

During the initial accident investigation, it was determined a 30-year-old male driver of a 2006 Lexus sedan was travelling west on Walnut Street when he struck a 29-year-old female pedestrian. The pedestrian was walking east across Walnut Street, and directly in the path of the Lexus sedan, when she was struck outside of a crosswalk.

The injured female pedestrian was transported to St. Elizabeth Hospital for treatment of major injuries. The driver immediately pulled his vehicle over after the collision and was cooperative with investigating officers. Alcohol does not appear to be a factor in the collision.
