Supplement Title: Initial

On Thursday, June 19, 2025 at approximately 0920 hours Rocky River police received a 911 call from congressman Max L Miller reporting a male in a black Tesla, OH Reg. KID8279 was tailgating his vehicle and attempted to run him off the road while traveling on Interstate 90. He stated to RRPD dispatch that the male stated he was going to "Kill him and his daughter". While on the phone dispatcher Nowicki stated that the male could be heard beeping his horn at the caller. Prior to RRPD units arriving on scene Miller stated that both he and the suspect vehicle exited Interstate 90 at the McKinley Rd. exit ramp. The area was searched and the vehicle in question was not located. Miller advised dispatch that he would be in later in the day to report the incident and complete a statement and would also be contacting Capitol Police. I contacted Miller via phone to speak with him regarding the incident. He stated that he would re-arrange his schedule and attempt to come to the police station as early as he could. He stated that he had already spoken to Capitol Police and that they would be investigating the incident and providing resources for protection services for Miller and his family. Westlake and Bay Village Police were contacted and made aware of the incident.

I contacted United States Capitol Police and spoke with SSA Keith R Dworak with the investigations unit. He stated that Miller had already contacted Capitol Police and advised them of the incident. He stated that they would be investigating the incident and provided me with his contact information. He asked that we did not make contact with the suspect at that time as they were also actively investigating and possibly pursuing federal charges. I then was contacted by SA John P Flickinger who stated that they would be responding to Ohio to investigate the incident and asked that we proceed with our investigation and arrest the suspect if criminal charges applied.

At approximately 1530 hours, congressman Max Miller arrived on station to speak with officers. Due to not having previously spoken to Miller, a Lakewood Police Officer Ptl. Ehmer badge #73 was also on scene to determine the jurisdiction where the incident took place. Det. Asbury, Ptl. Ehmer, and I then brought Miller in to the soft interview room to speak with him. Miller stated that he left his home at approximately 0905 hours to attend his first meeting of the day. He turned on to Interstate 90 eastbound from Columbia Rd. and entered the freeway. He stated that as he entered the City of Rocky River he was approached by a black Tesla vehicle. He stated that the Tesla operator started to beep his horn over and over and then pulled side to side with Miller's vehicle. He stated that when the vehicle owner did not get his attention he swerved his vehicle in to the lane of Miller causing him to also swerve his vehicle and almost lose control. He stated that he felt scared during the interaction and continued on eastbound slowing down his speed to approximately 40 MPH in an attempt to have the vehicle continue on past him. He stated that the vehicle operator then also slowed his vehicle and traveled next to Miller's vehicle. The male operator then showed Miller his phone which had a Palestinian flag on it with writing underneath he could not make out. Miller stated that the male driver of the Tesla vehicle was screaming and shouting out of his window that was down. Miller said he rolled down his window to hear what he was screaming and stated that the man shouted to him that he was "going to kill me", "going to

kill my family", "Free Palestine", "Death to Israel", and "Fuck Jews". He stated that he continued to scream other things but he does not remember what else was said. Miller stated that he slowed his vehicle more and attempted to get behind the vehicle to obtain a license plate. Miller stated that he eventually was able to maneuver behind the suspect vehicle and obtained the license plate of OH Registration KID8279. Both vehicles then exited Interstate 90 at the McKinley Rd. exit ramp where Miller stated the vehicle stopped and continued to yell over to Miller who also stopped his vehicle. Miller stated that the vehicle operator then sped off in front and left the area. Miller completed a written signed statement that is attached to the report.

A LEADS search of the vehicle was conducted which showed Abdallah Y Ali DOB 6/1/1981 as the registered owner of KID8279. Lt. Blazer and Lt. Wagner were advised. Det. Asbury created a photo line-up of 6 individuals which included Ali as one of the photos.

While in the soft interview room, Miller was provided a photo line up created by Det. Asbury and administered by Lakewood PD Ptl. Ehmer who had not seen the line up photos or an photos of the suspect prior to administering. Miller identified #3, which was a positive identification of the registered owner of OH Reg. KID8279, the Tesla vehicle in question. ODOT camera footage was viewed by Det. Asbury, Lt. Wagner, and I while Miller completed his written statement. Both vehicles are observed on the ODOT cameras of Interstate 90 traveling eastbound within the city limits of Rocky River. At one point in the video the Tesla vehicle, traveling in the far left fast lane rapidly jerks the vehicle close to the middle lane where Miller was traveling and then merge behind him. It then shows a portion of time where both vehicles are traveling next to one another in the lanes of travel side by side. Later in the video it shows Miller speed up his vehicle and get directly behind the Tesla. Miller was brought to the detective bureau to watch the video footage from ODOT. He explains that in the soft interview room he thought that he was the one traveling in the high speed lane but had the orientation backward and that the Tesla was operating in the fast lane. He stated that when the vehicles were side by side, is when the verbal exchange took place. He stated that the last part of the video showed when he sped up quickly and attempted to get right behind the Tesla to confirm the license plate while on the phone with dispatch. Due to the information obtained by officers, a written complaint was completed for Abdallah Y Ali for Orc. 2903.21/Aggravated Menacing. Miller signed the complaint and signed a TPO. Deborah Comery from the Clerk of Courts was contacted and warrants were obtained. Det. Asbury, Det. Hill, Lt. Wagner, and Ptl. Hageman with Aux. officer Schaffer then attempted warrant service on Abdallah Y Ali. See the supplemental report from responding officers regarding additional information obtained and identification of the operator of the vehicle.

Supplement Title: 06/19/2025 Response Health Express

On 06/19/2025 at 1851 hrs., Lt. Wagner, Det. Asbury, Ptl. Shirkey, and I responded to Health Express Urgent Care Centers located at 1400 W. Pleasant Valley Rd. Immediately visible in the rear parking lot of the business was the suspect vehicle, OH REG:KID8279 a Black Tesla. Parma PD was present as they were maintaining surveillance. The Tesla was subsequently towed to Rocky River Police Department garage.

We spoke with the front desk receptionist and asked if Feras was there and she said yes. The receptionist left the front for about a minute and returned with another co-worker. When I asked for Feras, the co-worker said she didn't know where Feras was at. The co-worker said they received a contact number to the police and said that Dr. Ali would get in touch with that contact number. She then said that Feras is not Dr. Ali and that they were two different people. I told her that we wanted to talk with Feras quick and she said she didn't think he was available. I asked her who drove the Tesla today and she said that she didn't know who drives what. I asked what the doctor normally drives when he comes to work. She asked which doctor. I said either doctor, Feras or Ali and she said she doesn't know what anyone drives. I asked her who would know who drives the Tesla. I told her to find someone that knows. I asked a male worker and he said he doesn't know who drives the Tesla. Everyone at the office was completely uncooperative and obstructing the investigation. Lt. Wagner then asked the initial co-worker if Feras was unavailable and if he was here and she said that she didn't know. She then said she saw him earlier. I asked her if she was saying they have no doctors here and she said we have providers who are seeing patients too. Det. Asbury asked why Feras was so afraid to come to the front to speak with us since he had just spoken to him on the phone. She said that she didn't know and that she doesn't talk with the doctors about personal matters. Det. Asbury then advised her that the Tesla was involved in a crime. Feras then came to the front and said he gave the officer his information. He said Dr. Ali isn't here. I asked if he drove the Tesla today and he then put a phone that was on speaker in front of me and told "Issa" to talk. I kept asking Feras if he drove the Tesla and he ignored me and pointed to the phone. Issa ended up being Feras' attorney and he told me to quit asking his client questions. He then told me to write his number down which was [REDACTED] and that he would answer any questions.

We then cleared the Health Express Urgent Care and responded to Strongsville where Strongsville PD had detained Abdallah Ali and were awaiting our arrival to speak with him.

Upon arriving in Strongsville near Abdallah Ali's residence where he was being detained on a RRMCM Warrant for Aggravated Menacing by Strongsville PD, we interviewed Abdallah.

Strongsville PD had detained Abdallah in the parking lot of Kinsner Elementary. Det. Asbury had mirandized Abdallah prior to questioning. After speaking with Abdallah he was able to confirm after making several phone calls that the Tesla in question was being driven that day by Feras Hamdan who is a doctor that works for him. Abdallah explained that he has three Tesla's in his name that are used for the business. Abdallah stated that he allows doctors that work for him to use the vehicles.

I spoke with Feras' attorney Elkhatib, and advised him that Det. Asbury was processing the Tesla and asked if we could obtain DNA standards from Feras. Elkhatib agreed and advised Feras to provide consent. I then completed a consent to search form to obtain DNA standards from Feras, which Feras signed.

1851 Hours – Parma, OH

Detectives Hill and Asbury, Patrolman Shirkey, and I responded to Health Express Urgent Care located at 1400 W. Pleasant Valley Road to interview employees regarding the ongoing investigation. Upon arrival, the suspect vehicle, a black 2023 Tesla bearing Ohio registration KID 8279, was immediately visible in the rear parking lot. Parma Police Department was already on scene conducting surveillance.

The Tesla was eventually towed from the scene to the Rocky River Police Department evidence garage bay by Kufner's Towing. Officer Hageman followed the towed vehicle back to RRPD to ensure proper chain of custody.

1937 Hours – Strongsville, OH

Later that evening, RRPD personnel responded to the area near Abdallah Ali's residence and located Strongsville Police Department officers with Ali in the parking lot of 19091 Waterford Parkway. Ali was being detained by Strongsville PD on a Rocky River Municipal Court warrant for Aggravated Menacing.

Detective Asbury advised Ali of his Miranda rights prior to questioning. When asked if he could determine who had possession of his Tesla at approximately 0920 hours that morning, Ali agreed to make several phone calls, including one to his business partner. Ali explained that they co-own several medical facilities.

During the phone call, the partner informed investigators that Feras Hamdan had possession of the vehicle at the time in question. It was noted that Ali and Hamdan share very similar facial characteristics, which has investigative relevance.

Ali signed a consent form authorizing a search of any video stored within the Tesla. He declined to provide a written statement, but a verbal statement was captured on body-worn camera (BWC). ALI also indicated that HAMDAN would be responding to RRPD with his attorney to turn himself in on this evening.

Present during the interview were RRPD personnel Lieutenant Wagner, Detective Asbury, Detective Hill, and Officer Shirkey, as well as officers from the Strongsville Police Department.

Supplement Title: Aggravated Menacing Investigation

On 06/19/2025, at approximately 1300 hours, I was made aware of this incident and that Max Miller was going to be responding to the station later in the afternoon to speak with officers about the incident. Sgt. Rodriguez had already been speaking with Capitol Police and it was decided that a photo lineup would be conducted. I began to prepare a photo lineup together that including the registered owner of Ohio registration KID8279, which is Abdallah Ali. Using OHLEG and the photo lineup tool, I was able to locate pictures of 5 other males that matched the description of Ali. The descriptors included a dark beard, dark hair, age +/- 2 years, weight +/-20 lbs and race. After locating 5 additional photographs of male that matched the description of Ali, I began putting the photographs into separate folders as the instructions on OHLEG stated. The instructions also stated to place 4 pieces of blank white paper into separate envelopes so that a total of 10 folders are used. Ali's BMV photograph was placed into one of the first 6 folders and the folders were then numbered per the instructions 1-6. The folders containing blank pieces of paper were each numbered 7-10.

Sgt. Rodriguez advised that Lakewood PD was sending an officer over to assist with the interview process. That officer, Ptl. Ehmer, was asked to administer the photo lineup since had no idea who was in the photo lineup and he became the blind administrator for the lineup. He was given directions on how to complete the photo lineup and Ptl. Ehmer, Sgt. Rodriguez and I, all went to the soft interview room to speak with Max Miller. The photo lineup was administered the first time and Miller took a longer look at folder #3. The second time through the photo lineup, Miller looked at folder #1 and made comments regarding how it looked the suspect, but eventually stated that his face looked a little thicker/rounder/fatter. As he looked at folder #3 again, he described the male in the photograph and eventually stated that the suspect involved in this incident was the male in folder #3. Miller also stated that he was 95% sure it was him when asked how confident he was.

See Sgt. Rodriguez's supplement for more information about the interview conducted with Miller, but Miller stated that he and the other vehicle both slowed down to around 40-45 mph and at one point the driver of the Tesla pulled up a Palestinian flag on his phone, and placed it on the driver's window while driving next to Miller. Miller also stated that he could hear the male say tha the was going to kill him and his family and that he was going to make a parking lot out of his house. Miller said that he understood the significance of that statement due to a 2023 comment made by Miller where he stated that Palestine will be turned into a parking lot.

Working in conjunction with Sgt. Rodriguez and the Capitol Police, it was decided that an aggravated menacing complaint would be completed for Ali and a warrant would be obtained. Prior to the warrant and complaint being completed, the ODOT video footage was obtained and reviewed. Miller was brought to the RRPD Detective Bureau to review the camera footage as well. This was done while also reviewing the 911 call audio from Miller. Initially, Miller stated he was in the fast lane but based on the video footage, he was actually in the middle lane and the right lane/slow speed lane. While listening to the 911 audio, dispatcher Nowicki requested a license plate from Miller and while reviewing both, it appears that Miller may have sped back up and gotten behind the black Tesla to acquire the license plate.

The criminal complaint for aggravated menacing was signed by Miller and a warrant was obtained. After the warrant was obtained, open source searches of Ali revealed that he has an

urgent care type of business called Health Express in Parma at 1400 West Pleasant Valley Road . Flock cameras were checked and they revealed license plate hits in that area earlier in the day. Parma PD was contacted to check the business for the vehicle and they located it in the rear of the parking lot a short time later. RRPD units that included myself, Lt. Wagner, Ptl. Shirkey, Det. Hill, and Ptl. Hageman, all responded to the location after Parma PD attempted to talk to the people inside, particularly Feras Hamdan, the physician working at the time. I also attempted to speak with Hamdan on the phone before arriving and he stated that he was speaking with Parma PD and working with them. I asked him for his name and he hung up the phone before providing it

Once I arrived at Health Express, RRPD officers went inside the business and began to speak with staff. A female employee stated that she didn't know if Feras was even there even though officers had been there the whole time from when Parma PD spoke to him and when RRPD arrived. Every employee claimed not to know who drives the Tesla and nobody would say if Feras was there. Eventually, after much back and forth, Feras emerged and came to the lobby counter. He had his phone on and began telling Det. Hill to speak with his attorney on the phone. Parma PD officers on scene also informed me that they checked their CAD system on scene and that Hamdan was stopped recently in the Tesla with Ohio registration KID8279 in Parma. The date of the traffic stop was June 13th, 2025. I asked to see the BMV photograph of Hamdan at that time and observed similarities between Hamdan and Ali.

While this was all going on, Ali was contacted by Strongsville PD since he lives in Strongsville. He was initially detained on his warrant and driven around the corner of his residence where he waited with them until RRPD officers arrived. Once we arrived in Strongsville, I provided Ali with his Miranda Rights and asked him to step out of the Strongsville PD cruiser. He was not in handcuffs at the time he was removed from the vehicle. See. Det. Hill's supplement for more regarding the conversation with Ali. Ali was eventually able to contact his attorney and revealed who was driving the Tesla at the time of the incident with Miller. Ali stated that he has multiple Tesla's and they're all business cars and that mostly the physicians drive them. Feras Hamdan was identified as the driver at that time. It should be noted that Hamdan and Ali at the time of this offense, both had black beards that were almost identical and their hair was similar. Both males looked very similar at the time of this incident.

Feras made arrangements to turn himself in with his attorney at RRPD a short time later. At approximately 2230 hours, Hamdan showed up to the RRPD lobby. He was now clean shaven, had his hair done/combed, and was dressed in a suit. He also provided the Tesla key card so that we can gain access to the interior of the Tesla to review the video footage from the Tesla. Prior to leaving Strongsville, Ali provided us with written consent to search the vehicle, review the cameras and the video footage. He instructed Feras to bring the key card with him when he turned himself in.

I captured photographs of the exterior and interior of the Tesla and then collected swabs of the steering wheel and gear shifter. The Sentry camera system was still activated and on while parked in RRPD's garage. I was able to review the video footage from the Tesla and located a video from 06/19/2025 at 0853 in the morning. The video shows Hamdan wearing what appears to be his scrubs in front of the vehicle and walking to the driver's side. He stands by the driver's door for a short time using his cell phone and then appears to enter the car. This video was initiated in Avon it appears based on the video footage. No video footage was found that would assist with the details of the event on Interstate 90. I checked the settings for the dash camera in the Tesla and found that the dash camera was set to which means it will save up to 10 minutes of video to the USB flash drive in the glove box automatically when the vehicle detects a safety

event such as an accident or airbag deployment. Due to dash camera's settings being set to this , no video footage was captured during the actual event. The USB drive was still removed and entered into evidence.

Additionally, a white Apple iPhone with a clear cover on it was found in the center console underneath the control screen. It was also removed and entered into evidence. The vehicle contained several documents and items with Hamdan's name on them. Most were mailings with addreses in Cleveland and Avon. A recent traffic ticket issued to Hamdan was also found in the vehicle (See report photos). These items were photographed but were left in the vehicle. A search warrant will be considered for the cellular device found in the vehicle. Tesla key turned over to Det. Hill.

Supplement Title: 1685 Sperrys Forge Trail

On 06/25/2025, I met with RPMC Judge Burke to review a search warrant that I prepared for 1685 Sperrys Forge Trail in Westlake, Ohio. Judge Burke reviewed the warrant and signed it a short time later. The address was discovered to be of interest after the records provided through T-Mobile's search warrant response was received. The address was also discovered to be associated with Gihad Mahmoud Zayed who is suspected of having come to the RRPD lobby with Hamdan when he turned himself in. Gihad was determined to be with Hasan Saleh and possibly operating Ohio registration HEB4731, a 2017 Honda registered to Saleh. This was corroborated through review of the Rocky River PD lobby cameras and exterior cameras.

While Hamdan was here to turn himself in, Saleh and Gihad were here also here with Attorney Elkhatib. I asked Elkhatib about Hamdan's cell phone and where it was. Elkhatib inquired as to why we wanted his cell phone and we discussed the alleged Palestinian flag that was shown as part of this incident. While this conversation was going on, Saleh and Gihad were close by and one of them made a comment regarding the case. Video footage shows the two of them sitting down in the lobby and eventually walking outside of the front doors near the parking lot in front of the main doors to the police department. They were observed speaking with Elkhatib at that time and then Saleh and Gihad left together also.

While reviewing the call detail records, the records show that the device associated with [REDACTED] is near 1685 Sperrys Forge Trail in Westlake on 06/19/2025 at 0036 hours. The device returns to the area of 36698 Gosford Drive in Avon around 0046 hours. The device remains in this area until approximately 0857 hours on 06/19/2025. The device appears to have been moving with a vehicle based on the records and appears to have entered Interstate 90 eastbound from SR 254 in Sheffield at approximately 0910-0912 hours. Further review of the records show the device moving along a path consistent with eastward movement on Interstate 90 eastbound. At approximately 0919 hours, the device is west of the Clague Road entrance ramp and proceeding east. At approximately 0922 hours, the device is near the area of the city limits of Rocky River on Interstate 90 eastbound. This is significant in that it is consistent with ODOT video footage showing the Tesla vehicle in the area around this time also. This is also where and when some of the interaction between Miller and Hamdan is captured on cameras by ODOT.

The device continues to move eastbound on Interstate 90 and at approximately 0923 hours the device is in the area of Interstate 90 eastbound and the Wooster Road overpass. Again, this is corroborated by ODOT cameras that show the Tesla in the same area at 09:22:36 hours. The Tesla and the device both end up in the area of 1400 West Pleasant Valley Road in Parma at approximately 0948 hours. The device remains in that area for a significant amount of time even while Parma PD and RRPD officers are at 1400 West Pleasant Valley Road attempting to speak with Hamdan and when the Tesla was located in the rear of the lot there.

The device, determined to be an Apple iPhone 12 Pro Max with [REDACTED], remains in this area until approximately 2000 hours on the 19th. Around this same time, it appears that HEB4731, the Honda that's registered to Saleh, is captured on Flock cameras in Seven Hills near Broadview Rd and Pleasant Valley Road eastbound at 1959 hours. Based on this information, it appears that Saleh's vehicle was driven to possibly transport Hamdan back to his residence in Avon. The call detail records and specialized historical location data show the device back in the area of 36698 Gosford Drive in Avon, which is known to be the residential address of Hamdan. The device remains in this area and is still showing in the area of 2205

hours. Hamdan turned himself in at approximately 2222 hours. The device did not leave the area of his residence during that time. Again, Saleh and Gihad were observed on cameras pulling into the police department and exiting Saleh's Honda vehicle. Based on the video footage, it appears that Attorney Elkhatib transported Hamdan in his own vehicle.

At approximately 2304 hours, the device associated with 0148 begins to move eastbound from Gosford Drive. The device is in the area of 1685 Sperrys Forge Trail around 2319 hours. The device remains in this area until 0930 hours on 06/20/2025, when it leaves and heads to the area of 36698 Gosford Drive in Avon. The device arrives in this area around 0943 hours. Once the device is at that location, the device has no specialized historical location data communications with the network for over 44 minutes. This can often be due to the phone being turned off or the phone being placed in airplane mode, which restricts/limits connectivity with the mobile network provider and cell sites. This occurs again for a second time while the device is still near Gosford Drive in Avon. The device remains in this area until approximately 1154 hours when it leaves and goes back to the area of 1685 Sperrys Forge Trail in Westlake. The device remains in this area over the course of the next few days and the last specialized historical location data seen in the search warrant response provided by T-Mobile shows the device in the area of 1685 Sperrys Forge Trail in Westlake on 06/22/2025 at 2007 hours.

Based on this information, I conducted research into Gihad Zayed and discovered that he has previously lived at this address and that a total of 4 males including Mahmoud Zayed, Gihad Zayed, Mohammad Zayed and Jamal Zayed, all have listed addresses or previous addresses at 1685 Sperrys Forge Trail. Additionally, while reviewing the RRPD cameras, it's clearly seen that both Gihad and Saleh are seen using their phones. However, both Saleh and Gihad were still at RRPD after 2304 hours when the device associated with 0148 leaves the area of the residence at Gosford Drive in Avon. At this point in time, they can be ruled out as potentially transporting the device from Gosford Drive to Sperrys Forge Trail based on review of the security camera footage. I was wearing a latex glove, asked Mahmoud Zayed for the pass code which he provided as [REDACTED] for the purpose of opening the cell phone to confirm the IMEI number which was later done when Det. Asbury arrived on scene. Mahmoud provided his DOB of [REDACTED] and cell phone number [REDACTED]. I placed the phone in a paper bag and later placed it into evidence under PT#20904. Det. Asbury spoke with Gihad Zayed which is Mahmoud Zayed's son, who had arrived about 5 minutes after we had made contact with Mahmoud. Det. Asbury and I confirmed the IMEI number of [REDACTED] thereby confirming that this was Feras Hamdan's cell phone. I completed a search warrant inventory and provided a copy of it to Mahmoud Zayed.

On 06/26/2025, I met with Law Director O'Shea and Attorney Elkhatib. A review of the cellular records was provided to both and Attorney Elkhatib was shown the locations of the device associated with 0148 before, during, and after the incident. He was also advised that a residential search warrant was obtained for 1685 Sperrys Forge Trail and provided an opportunity to have the residents turn the device over to RRPD officers who were in the area waiting. Real-time/provisional records still showed that the device was not communicating with the T-Mobile network and it was last seen in the area of 1685 Sperrys Forge Trail. He was advised that the search warrant obtained covered all cellular devices in the residence due to the fact that the device may have been powered off and that it would be necessary to possibly perform a forensic extraction on the devices to see which one had the matching IMEI number of the device Hamdan is associated with. He eventually agreed to have someone bring the device out and to have them power on the device and confirm that it was the correct IMEI.

Mahmoud Zayed walked out of the residence and turned the device over to Det. Hill and Lt. Wagner. He also provided the passcode to the device and it was confirmed at that time that the device he provided was in fact the device associated with Hamdan and phone number [REDACTED]. I went to the residence and noticed that Jihad was also on scene. He agreed to speak with me and I advised him that he could potentially be charged with tampering with evidence due to the phone being moved from Avon to Westlake and then staying at the Sperrys Forge Trail address for a few days. He was also provided his Miranda Rights and stated that he wished to not answer questions. As Det. Hill was completing the search warrant inventory, Mahmoud stated that he would've just turned the phone over to us. Jihad spoke up and stated that he was just doing as he was instructed by Issa (Attorney Elkhatib) and said that he was not to turn the phone over until they were served with the paperwork. I mentioned how that what he said indicated that Attorney Elkhatib knew that the device was at this residence even after being made clearly aware that RRPD sought the device as part of its investigation.
