Project Greenlight is an American documentary television series produced by Matt Damon and Ben Affleck that focuses on first-time filmmakers being given the chance to direct a feature film. In 2015, Jason Mann won the competition.

Project Greenlight is an American documentary television series focusing on first-time filmmakers being given the chance to direct a feature film. Shortly after winning the competition, Jason Mann went on to produce a comedy film for Project Greenlight called, "The Leisure Class." InCounty magazine reporter Jim Goetz spoke with Mann shortly after the movie was released.

Jason Mann was nine years old when he started writing songs as a hobby, but changed direction when he made his first short film. In fact, Mann never stopped. He went on studying to be a filmmaker and today holds a Masters Degree from Columbia University. Mann said, "School prepared me...making HBO's movie was very similar." After winning the competition, Mann announced that he wanted to re-write the script. A very bold move and something that is unheard of after winning his spot as the director.

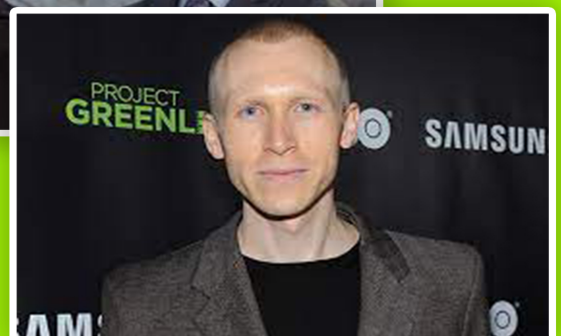
Mann did not stop there. In fact, Mann wanted the movie shot on 35 mm film, which is very expensive. "Film is very important to me. Even if the scenes are horrible, the pictures are beautiful," Mann claimed. The request to make the change did not go very well with the shows producers. But in the end, Mann got his way and the movie was better for it.

Filmmaking goes beyond shooting and editing. Casting is also very important. Mann had always liked actor Tom Bell and thought he was a terrific talent. "The cast of this movie was one of the greatest joys of making this movie, especially Tom (Bell) and Ed (Weeks)," Mann reported. "In fact, we loved Tom Bell and Ed Weeks together, only to find out the two were best friends behind the camera."

The show "Project Greenlight" has a ton of twists and turns that come with movie making. Mann holds his own and defies critics in the end. He made a ton of special requests that many questioned, but hit the mark as "The Leisure Class" became a very successful film. In May 2021, HBO Max picked up the series with an 8-episode order and will be produced by Issa Rae through her production company Hoorae. -- Previous episodes can be found on HBO MAX.

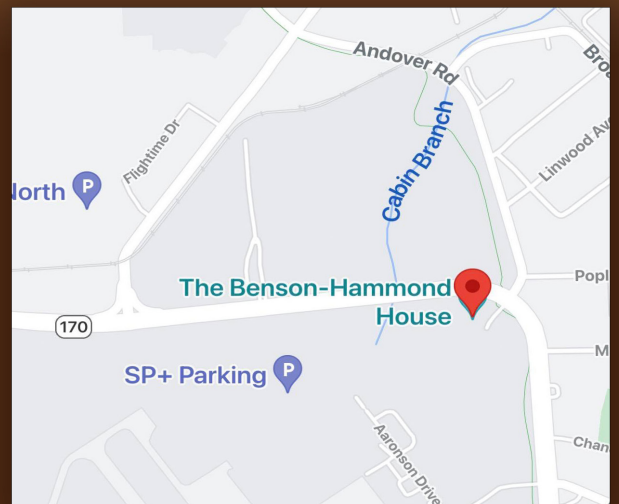

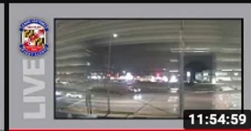

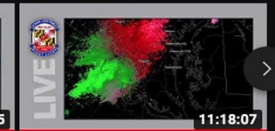
