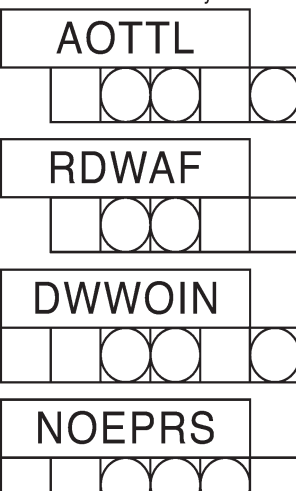

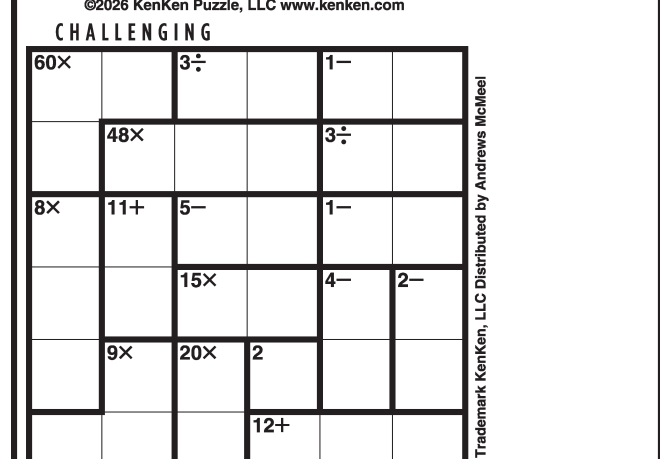


## KENKEN

THE LOGIC PUZZLE THAT MAKES YOU SMARTER.



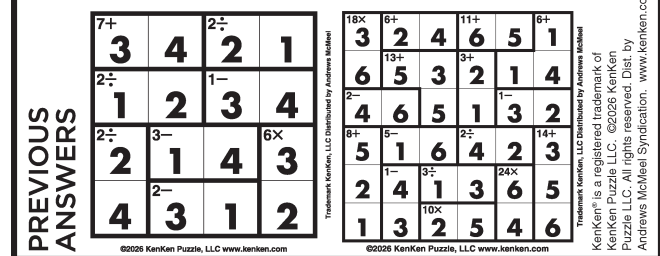
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### RULES
