Village of Hammond Multi Use Trail Extension

Multiple Streets

St. Croix County

The Village of Hammond, in cooperation with the Wisconsin Department of Transportation (WisDOT), is considering a multi use trail and sidewalk extension project along portions of Broadway Street, Ridgeway Street, and West Street between St. Croix Central High School and Davis Street/WIS 12 in the Village of Hammond, St. Croix County, WI. The proposed project would involve:

- Construction of an asphalt multi use trail along Broadway Street between St. Croix Central High School and West Street;
- Construction of concrete sidewalk along Broadway Street between West Street and Davis Street/WIS 12;
- Construction of concrete sidewalk along Ridgeway Street between Charlotte Street and Broadway Street; and
- Removal and existing roadway pavement and replacement with an asphalt trail along West Street between Broadway Street and Meadows Drive.

The project area would remain open during construction. Traffic would be managed with potential lane closures. Access would be maintained to adjacent properties for the High School, residents, and emergency services. Construction is anticipated for the fall of 2027. Approximately 0.5 acres of real estate (primarily temporary limited easements) is expected to be needed to complete the project. Potential Section 4(f) and other environmental impacts are being evaluated during the design process.

A Public Involvement Meeting will be held on July 9, 2026 from 5-6 pm at the Village of Hammond Village Hall located at 455 Davis Street, Hammond, WI 54015. Project representatives will be available at that time to discuss the proposed project and address any questions or concerns from the public.

The objective of the public involvement outreach is to provide property owners, interested citizens, and public officials with an opportunity to comment on the design for this project. The public is encouraged to view the project information at the webpage below and submit any comments or concerns they may have. Comments may be submitted until August 10, 2026.

Those who are deaf, hard of hearing, blind, have low vision, or are speech disabled can use the Wisconsin Telecommunication Relay System (WTRS).
