Re: Talking Points for Town Meetings on the Proposed Amended Regional Agreement

Why are we voting on a new regional school agreement and what is different about this document?

- I. The proposed agreement has been updated to be compliant with all law and regulation regarding regional school districts.
- II. The original agreement was amended several times since the formation of the district and although these amendments were approved locally, they were never approved by the Massachusetts Department of Education which is required. This updated agreement has been preliminarily approved by DESE and the Commissioner will sign off after the towns approve the document.
- III. The proposed updated agreement now includes a required provisions regarding Other Post-Employment Benefits (OPEB) and pension liabilities. With these provisions, all member towns carry their fair share of these costs in the event that a town is added or if a town withdraws.
- IV. The proposed agreement more clearly describes the budget and apportionment process that is currently used by the District.
- V. The proposed updated agreement provides for two pathways for towns that may choose to withdraw at some point in the future.
- VI. The agreement also provides more clarity regarding the process to amend the agreement.
- VII. There is a provision in the agreement for five-year reviews of the document should there be a need for future changes or upgrades.
