


City of Pittsfield Curbside Collection: 2024-2025 Schedule



HOLIDAYS

September 2, 2024 - Labor Day Delay Monday through Saturday

November 28, 2024 – Thanksgiving Delay Thursday though Saturday

December 25, 2024 – Christmas Delay Wednesday through Saturday

January 1, 2025 – New Year's Day Delay Wednesday through Saturday

May 26. 2025 – Memorial Day Delay Monday through Saturday

July 4. 2025 – Independence Day Delay Friday through Saturday

September 1. 2025 - Labor Day Delay Monday through Saturday

November 27, 2025 – Thanksgiving Delay Thursday though Saturday

December 25, 2025 - Christmas Delay Thursday through Saturday





Pittsfield Recycles!

Alternate the use of your recycling cart with paper & cardboard, and cans, bottles, & plastic into another. Please **EMPTY** and **RINSE** all carts and **flatten** and **break down** cardboard boxes.

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GRAY SHADED WEEK





Clean paper, cardboard, pizza box greeting cards & wrapping paper (no foils or metallics), paperback & phone books with covers; paper clips, staples & metal spirals are ok

BLUE SHADED WEEK



Metal cans, foil, glass bottles & jars, plastic bottles, jars, tubs & jugs, clear plastic hinged containers (clamshells), (health, beauty, food only); labels and caps on bottles are ok





NOT ACCEPTED: Plastic bags, bagged recyclables, clothing/textiles, food waste/liquids, tanglers such as rope or hoses, scrap metal, batteries of any kind, electronics, wood, medical waste, hazardous materials, explosives, toys, hangers, shoes, waxy cups or plates, food bags or wrappers, plastic wrap or film, shrink wrap, tarps, diapers, human/pet or yard waste, tires or rubber, Styrofoam™, napkins, paper towels, tissues, plastic utensils, register tape, condiment packets, straws, stirrers, coffee pods, ceramics, aerosol cans, shredded paper



Frequently Asked Questions

How should I prepare recyclables?

Recyclables must be empty and rinsed clean of food residue. Corrugated cardboard boxes should be broken down into 2' max pieces.

What bins do I use?

You must use the recycling cart provided by Casella for all recycling. Please take note of what materials are accepted each week by referencing the recycling calendar on the reverse side.

Can I still use the small blue bins?

You may use the small blue bins to sort your recyclables, but you will need to transfer these materials into the recycling cart for pick up on your designated day.

How can I discard a large item?
