

2. Extent and Type of Activity (if more space is required, please attach a separate sheet):

The site is located within of near the playing areas of an eighteen-hole golf course associated with the Country Club of Pittsfield. Unauthorized activities included the removal of woody (including hydrophytic shrubs and mature trees) and herbaceous vegetation (including hydrophytic herbs) and land grading with no evidence of significant grade change within, Bordering Land Subject to Flooding (310 CMR 10.57), Bordering Vegetated Wetlands (310 CMR 10.55), Inland Bank (310 CMR 10.54), and associated buffer zones (310 CMR 10.04).

Such activity is spread out over the low-lying portions of the golf course and will require site survey to bes approximate the extent of resource and buffer zone impacts.			

B. Findings

The Issuing Authority has determined that the activity described above is in a resource area and/or buffer zone and is in violation of the Wetlands Protection Act (M.G.L. c. 131, § 40) and its Regulations (310

plan shall also include a detailed wetland resource area delineation and field survey that is to be shown on topographic base plan having 1' contour intervals and tied into the FEMA survey datum. The restoration shall be completed in accordance with the conditions and timetable established by the issuing authority. C. Order (cont.) Complete the attached Notice of Intent (NOI). The NOI shall be filed with the Issuing Authority on or before: Date for the following: No further work shall be performed until a public hearing has been held and an Order of Conditions has been issued to regulate said work. The property owner shall take the following action (e.g., erosion/sedimentation controls) to prevent further violations of the Act: Failure to comply with this Order may constitute grounds for additional legal action. Massachusetts General Laws Chapter 131, Section 40 provides: "Whoever violates any provision of this section (a) shall be punished by a fine of not more than twenty-five thousand dollars or by imprisonment for not more than two years, or both, such fine and imprisonment; or (b) shall be subject to a civil penalty not to exceed twenty-five thousand dollars for each violation". Each day or portion thereof of continuing violation shall constitute a separate offense. D. Appeals/Signatures An Enforcement Order issued by a Conservation Commission cannot be appealed to the Department of Environmental Protection, but may be filed in Superior Court.
