All present gave pledge to the flag.
Baribeau made a motion to approve the minutes from the May 26th, 2021 Council meeting as presented. Zwiefelhofer seconded the motion and all present voted aye.

Meinen made a motion to approve all claims against the City and Utilities as presented. Zwiefelhofer seconded the motion and all present voted aye. The claims were in the amounts listed below:
