

PUBLIC NOTICE OF INTENT TO APPLY HERBICIDE

Vermont Electric Power Company, Inc. (VELCO) has applied for a right-of-way pesticide application permit through the Vermont Agency of Agriculture, Food and Markets for the purpose of making selective ground base applications of herbicides. These herbicides include: Aquamaster (Glyphosate), Escort XP (Metsulfuron Methyl), Garlon 4 Ultra (Triclopyr), Krenite S (Fosamine Ammonium) and Polaris (Isopropylamine salt of Imazapyr). Applications will be made on VELCOs 450 DC transmission line right-of-way located in the following counties and towns:

Caledonia County Waterford

Essex County Averill, Avery's Gore, Bloomfield, Brunswick, Concord, East Haven, Ferdinand, Granby, Lewis, Lunenburg, Norton, Victory

Herbicide application will start on Monday June 15, 2026.

Landowners adjacent to the areas in which will be treated should contact VELCO if private water supplies or other environmentally sensitive areas are located within 200 feet of the right-of-way edge. For further information please contact:
