EMS quickly transported her to NVRH. There, the highly-skilled Emergency Department team triaged, stabilized and readied her for helicopter transport. Within 90 minutes of her symptoms, she was in emergency surgery at Dartmouth Health. Now back home, she continues her rehabilitation with NVRH's Cardiac Rehab team and is back to creating art.
