The Cobleigh Public Library's Summer Learning Program (SLP) is officially here! Families can stop by the library any time to sign up for this great program where kids track their reading to earn a free book from Green Mountain Books & Prints, funded by a generous \$2,000 donation from our wonderful community education partner, Passumpsic Bank. On June 19th at 4 pm, the program will kick off during the first Family Fun Friday of the year, featuring a performance by the amazing Pirate Man Dan. There will be crafts, games, free books, and family-friendly activities for everyone to enjoy.

Other special events that families can look forward to this summer include:

- A children's program by Four Winds Nature Institute on June 26th.
- A honey bee program on July 10th called "The Buzz About Bees" by our very own Youth Librarian, Garrett Brinton, who is a long-time beekeeper.
- Another Family Fun Friday in Bandstand Park on July 10th featuring Ladder the Life-Sized Inflatable Whale, hosted by the Blue Ocean Society for Marine Conservation.
- The opportunity to decorate your bike on July 16th and ride with the "Cobleigh Crew" in the Stars & Stripes Parade on July 18th.
- A performance by the No Strings Marionette Company on July 24th.
- And finally, our Summer Reading Grand Finale on July 31st, featuring a presentation called "Birds Are Dinosaurs" by our friends from the Vermont Institute of Natural Sciences (VINS).

We also have many exciting SLP raffle prizes this year, including LEGO sets, art supplies, movie tickets from the Star Theatre in St. Johnsbury, toys from Little Village Toy & Book Shop in Littleton, a family 4-pack of passes to the Pump House Waterpark at Jay Peak, and more! Kids will be able to enter a ticket in the raffle of their choice up to once a week, beginning on Monday, June 8th, and there will be opportunities to enter additional "bonus" tickets for completing different SLP activities, such as attending a library program, showing progress on their Summer Reading Challenge trackers, etc.
