To direct and manage the Vermont State University Upward Bound Program, which offers programs and services intended to help low-income students do better in high school and go on to college.

MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS Master's degree in education, counseling, administration, or other appropriate discipline, plus two to four years of relevant counseling, teaching and administrative experience with secondary school experience desirable, or a combination of education and experience from which comparable knowledge and skills are acquired.
