**NOTICE OF TITLE V OPERATING PERMIT REVIEW
PUBLIC HEARING AND COMMENT PERIOD**

Pursuant to the New Hampshire Code of Administrative Rules, Env-A 622.02, notice is hereby given that the Director of the New Hampshire Department of Environmental Services, Air Resources Division (Director), has received an application for the renewal of a Title V Operating Permit from, and based on the information received to date, intends to **issue such Title V Operating Permit to:**

North Country Environmental Services, Inc.

The facility is a landfill located in Bethlehem, New Hampshire. The current landfill units (six lined cells: Stages I, II, III, IV, V and VI) occupy approximately 54 acres and municipal solid waste (MSW) has been placed in each of these landfill units. An active gas collection system consisting of a network of vertical extraction wells and horizontal gas collection trenches has been installed in the landfill. In addition, landfill gas (LFG) is also collected from several leachate collection pipes and tanks. Centrifugal blowers are used to extract gas from the landfill and either deliver the gas to one of two open flares or to a gas treatment system owned and operated by Rudarpa, Inc.

The Facility is a major source for sulfur dioxide (SO₂) and carbon monoxide (CO) and is therefore required to obtain a Title V Operating Permit.

The application and draft permit are on file with the Director, New Hampshire Department of Environmental Services, Air Resources Division, 29 Hazen Drive, P.O. Box 95, Concord, NH 03302-0095, (603) 271-1370. The application and draft permit are available through the NHDES OneStop online database (DES Interest ID: 3300990255). Requests for a public hearing and/or written comments filed with the Director in accordance with Env-A 622.05, and received no later than **June 22, 2026**, shall be considered by the Director in making a final decision.
