

## Bank Began In Derby Line, Grows To Become Community Leader

BY ROBIN SMITH Staff Writer

The hallmark of a bank, said Stephen Marsh, is

the extraordinary number of really good people who work there. That's certainly true for Community National Bank, celebrating 165 years.

From custodians to presidents, the 142 people who work for Community National Bank really like to serve people. Most have local roots, said Marsh, bank chairman and CEO.

That goes for the bank's new president, Kathy Austin, who grew up in Albany. Austin became president on Jan. 1, replacing Marsh.

Another example is Louise Bonvechio, CFO and senior vice president, who is from the Troy-Westfield area, Marsh said.

And they have longevity as well. Like Marsh, who has worked for the bank for more than 30 years, many of the staff have invested their careers at the bank.

They are local people helping local people, Marsh said.

"We are really lucky to have that flow."

Community National
Bank is the only publicly-traded company that has its headquar-

ters in Orleans County, he said.

The Derby bank office is the center of 14 branches across northern Vermont. And the history of the bank with its start in Derby Line has created

a special relationship with customers and business across the border in Quebec, Marsh said.

Community National Bank organized in 1851 as Peoples Bank and became the National Bank of Derby Line in 1865. The original bank office on

Main Street in Derby Line is still an operating branch.

In 1975, the bank acquired the Island Pond Na-

tional Bank and changed its name to Community National Bank, headquartered in Derby. In 1983, Community Bancorp., the bank's hold-

ing company, formed. The eighties were a period of growth, adding branches in Newport City and Troy to the Barton and Derby Line branches.

The nineties came with a recession in 1991,

which the bank overcame with a loan program that helped local businesses expand rather than pulling inward. The bank also introduced an electronic revolution in banking, with the first CNB ATM and

telephone banking, plus debit cards and Internet banking by the end of the decade.

In 1993, the bank stimulated the economy itself, opening its first major addition to the Derby office. The Island Pond office relocated to the historic train station. And the bank grew beyond Orleans County.

In 1999, the bank became the anchor owner of the new Emory A. Hebard State Office Building, a significant addition to downtown Newport City. On the bank's 150-year anniversary, a branch

opened in Montpelier, followed by Barre.

Community Financial Service Group, LLC, a trust company equally owned by Community National Bank, The National Bank of Middlebury and Guaranty Bancorp. and the holding company of Woodsville Guaranty Savings Bank, formed.

The Derby office expanded again in the aughts and the bank received the USDA Rural Development Lender of the Year Award for two years in a row.

At the end of 2007, major growth came when CNB acquired Lyndon-Bank.

Some of the changes brought by digital and mobile banking continue, Marsh said. The need for physical branch offices is changing as a result.

As for the future of growth in the Northeast Kingdom, Marsh said the impact of the EB-5 for-

eign investments at Jay Peak and QBurke resorts and beyond are being felt, with the full impact to come.

The NEK has need for what Marsh calls "really patient capital" that doesn't expect repayment for at least seven to 10 years. Banks cannot provide that, but EB-5 investors can, he said.

The bank benefited from good leadership over the years, Marsh said, from President Lloyd Selby (1959-1980), a "very good country banker whose word was his bond and expected people to do the

President Art Judd (1980-1986) "brought us into the electronic age" in the early eighties, followed by President Richard "Dick" White (1986-2004) who expanded those services with the policies and procedures in place to make sure it was successful, said Marsh, who rose through the ranks under both men.

Marsh said his own legacy will be reflected in the good people who follow him.

"The success stories we have in our community is fun to watch."

A brief history of your business:

My great-grandfather William H. Jenks started the Jenks Studio in 1886. I'm fourth generation keeping the Jenks Studio alive. We believe that we are the oldest family run photography business in the United States. Others have been around longer but sold out to nonfamily members.

After graduating from culinary school and not wanting to work in a hot kitchen over the summer, I started working for my dad and never stopped. Having my dad as a mentor, and surrounding myself around other creative photographers, I began my journey. My true love is black and white photography, but having to shoot color allowed me to adapt well, then this digital stuff showed up. I learned to treat it just like film, so we again adapted to it, as the world moves forward in technology my true love is to go back into the dark room like my great grandfather did. I still shoot with his 11x14 camera, and contact print on silver paper, and other even older processes like platinum & palladium printing. Our future goals include to get our history of files digitized to share with the world, to make a working teaching darkroom so that I can teach classes in B&W photography. When students graduate from high school, there is no place to keep working in the old ways. Now they could come back to town and have a darkroom to work in.

What makes your business unique? History makes my business unique!

One day while at Catamount Arts, I found a photo that my great-grandfather shot, then looking on the walls found some my grandfather shot, then some my father shot, I thought "WOW!" Three generations of Jenks photography here. Then I turned the corner, and on the wall was one that I had shot! Four generation of images in there!

## **JAX JR. CINEMAS**

## A Long History Of Big Star Power

The 65-year history of the The Jax Jr. Cinemas in Littleton, New Hampshire, is one of distinction and star power but it's family roots go back even further.

Jax Jr. opened on March 17, 1951.

The first movie shown was "Royal Wedding" starring June Powell and Fred Astaire. Congratulatory messages to owner John B. Eames were received from a host of Hollywood Greats including Bob Hope, Betty Hutton, Bing Crosby and Alan

In November 1952, the Jax Jr. received the Jay Emanuel Merit Award, the highest honor accorded by the Motion Picture Industry.

Sixty-five years and countless movies later, the Eames family still owns and operates the Jax Jr. located at 32 Main Street in downtown Littleton.

The Eames family's long run in theater management began in 1920 when Northumberland resident John B. Eames purchased the Star Theatre, then located in the Solomon Block.

"He moved south for the weather," said Eames' son Jere Eames. "That's what we like to say." But after the Star Theatre burned, the elder

Eames bought the 800-seat Premiere Theatre which was operating down the street. Then in 1949, tragedy struck again when the Premiere Theatre was also destroyed by fire.

"That's when he decided to build the most modern, fire-proof theatre he could," said Jere Eames. "And that's what he did. All concrete and sprin-

When the new theatre opened it was named Jax Jr. after another Theatre - "The Jax" - the Eames family had owned in Colebrook. On Feb. 8, 1975, the Jax Jr. had the distinction of

hosting the world premiere of a film near and dear to Littleton residents - because many of them were in it. The movie, shot on location in Littleton, with local residents taking part in some of the scenes, was titled "Two" and starred actress Sarah Venable. The film was later re-titled "Captive."

According to it's American Film Institute listing, "Captive" was directed by Charles Trieschmann and was premiered in Littleton, where principal photography had taken place for four months, over a fiveday period between Feb.

The film was shot in and around Littleton and the nearby White Mountain National Forest in the fall of 1973. An estimated 100 residents were used in small parts as extras. The fully-furnished cabin where much of the action took place was owned by a doctor from Boston, according to news accounts.

"Captive" tells the story of a ski instructor kidnapped by a Vietnam veteran who has taken refuge in the mountains where he spent part of his

childhood.

But by the 1970s, star-studded galas were nothing new to Littleton's little downtown movie the-

On April 5, 1941, the Premiere Theatre hosted the World Premiere of "The Great Lie" starring Bette Davis. The event coincided with Bette's birthday so it was a two-fold celebration attracting an estimated 10,000 spectators.

The Eames family, now in its third generation in the theatre business, have kept the Jax Jr. state of

Over the past decade, the Jax Jr. marquee has been redone with all neon and the interior lobby has been revamped. The seats installed in 1951 were replaced in 2007 with rocking-type chairs that total 225 per screen with a total theater capacity of 450.

In 1982, the single-screen movie theater was twinned for two screens. In the late 1980s, the sound was upgraded, and in 1999, when "Stars Wars: Episode I" was released, it was upgraded once again to Digital Theater Sound (DTS), which featured five speakers. In 2002, Cinema One in Jax Jr. went to Dolby digital sound.

On January 28, 2011, The Jax Jr. Cinemas became New Hampshire's first all-Digital 3D Cinema. The Dolby 3D system features high resolution and reusable glasses which are collected after each show and washed in between uses.

1997s "Titanic" was a big hit at Jax Jr. with some moviegoers turned away for lack of seats.

Until January of 2016, the first "Harry Potter" installment in 2001 held the record the most sales ever at the Jax Jr.

But Episode 7 of Stars Wars - "The Force Awakens" has topped them all and helped Jax Jr. have its best year ever, said Jere Eames.

It's all about having great movies and giving people a great place to see them," he said.





## **POULSEN LUMBER**

LITTLETON - What began as a lumber yard contracting with local loggers today has grown into a business that supplies a broad range of contractors, timberwrights and area residents.

Going strong into the 21st century, Poulsen Lumber Co. Inc., located at 656 Monroe Road at the northern edge of Littleton, celebrates 60 years in 2016. It has been owned by Allan and Christine Santy for

20 years. "We have a lot of customers and deal with a little bit of everyone, from contractors to homeowners,"

said Christine. In 1956, Andy Poulsen and his family got into the lumber business by purchasing Champlin Lumber Co., and during the first few years contracted with the

local loggers for raw material. In 1969, Andy's son, Val Poulsen, bought the business and began purchas-

ing delivered logs. As the years advanced, Poulsen upgraded the company's machinery, which is now fully mechanized

The yard is now a large purchaser of area timber, and today a handful of operators produce some 3 million board feet of lumber annually.

The mill produces special patterns for homeowners carrying out restoration in their homes.

It also has a wholesale wood pallet shop, said Christine.

Large customers include Pete and Gerry's Organic Eggs, of Monroe.

Although White Mountain Lumber Co. operates out of Berlin and Milan Lumber Co. nearby, Poulsen Lumber is the only of its kind with a saw mill in the Littleton area, he said.

Its wood chips are also purchased by local biomass plants, including the Ryegate Power Station in Ryegate and Pinetree Power plant Bethlehem (currently closed after a fire, but expected to be up and running again in the next few months.)

A sizable portion of what the company produces comes from pine harvested locally.

Although new product lines have been added, Christine spoke of the continuity through the years. "It's been in this location the whole time," she said. "It really hasn't changed much. We have a new addition on the front, but the sawmill is at the same spot."

Wood pallets have been made there for years and many building supplies and materials are sold. Pine is the company's specialty, but the mill also saws poplar, pine, spruce, fir and cedar and expanded





## THE FARMER'S DAUGHTER

## New Owners Promise To Stay True to Longheld Tradition

ST. JOHNSBURY - The Farmer's Daughter, a unique North Country gift shop which peddles maple syrup and homemade fudge, as well as all manner of unique souvenirs from here and afar, is marking its 50th year in

The business has new owners in recent years in Anna and Bruce Cushman. They are keeping the tradition of the funky popular tourist stop true to its spirit, while adding even more reasons for people to pull off Route 2. Shoppers can poke around both inside and outside the historic, inviting red barn.

The couple are the third owners of the business. They purchased it in the winter of 2012, and reopened it Mother's Day weekend, 2013.

On the Northeast Kingdom Chamber of Commerce's website, the business is celebrated as one of the longstanding traditions in the Northeast Kingdom's retail his-

"When the Farmer's Daughter first opened in the 1960s, it was one of the largest places in the region to find Vermont souvenirs and products, and that claim is still true today," the Chamber says. "Located in a gigantic, old barn, Farmer's Daughter is chockerblock full of quality Vermont-made products, furniture, specialty food and clothing, a number of these items made right in St. Johnsbury.

According to Anna Cushman, "We carry all the same tourist items that have been carried but we added an ice cream shoppe." They carry locally-made ice cream from Kingdom Creamery, as well as locally-made items soaps and lotions. They also make their own jams, jellies, homemade fudge and maple syrup.

The Cushmans added a new petting zoo, which is popular, said Anna Cushman.

"Families love the animals," she said. "We have goats, mini horses, alpacas, we also have wild ducks that spend the summer on our pond," adding that they try to add something new each year.

The Farmer's Daughter is open seven days a week from May to October and closes the day after Thanksgiving, opening across the street in a little sugar shack through Christmas, where they sell Christmas trees, fudge, and other local products each year, she said.

"It's so much fun meeting all the people that stop," she said. "This summer we had families from Israel, Russia, Australia and of course people traveling from all over the United States as well as the local folks that stop by for ice cream."

With a frisky wooden cutout sign of the farmer's daughter herself, her skirt hitching up inappropriately in a humorous, if not-so-politically correct manner, Cushman said that people often stop to take pictures with the sign. Anything that keeps them in the area is positive. "Shopping local helps keep business alive in the NEK," Cushman said.

The shop also stocks pottery, Bag Balm products made in nearby Lyndonville, furniture and wood crafts, jewelry, toys, bird feeders, wind chimes and much more.

A line of decorative primitive items also are featured at the gift shop from candles and candle holders to signs, kitchen items, dried berries and more.

Another new addition this past season under the new lead of the new owners was live flower baskets on the front porch, where "porch specials," change regularly.



## **QUALITY MITSUBISHI**

ST. JOHNSBURY - Quality Mitsubishi on Memorial Drive is marking its 50th anniversary, and business never looked better.

"We're very pleased with sales and all the support we are getting locally," said Ronney Lyster, co-owner of Autosaver Group, a company of car dealerships including Quality Mitsubishi. "We're very pleased with the growth of our fixed operations. Our service and parts departments have grown exponentially."

Lyster added, "Please stop by. We would love to meet you. We have a very experienced staff." The dealership employs 21 people.

Shelley Martin, the sales manager, is psyched about hitting the half century mark.

"How cool is that?" Martin said.

Autosaver Group is the business' second owner. The company purchased it in 2005 from founders Ernie Thurston and Bill Dimick.

It was named Quality Motors then and dealt only in used cars, Martin Autosaver said. quickly Group bought a Suzuki franchise to add new vehicles.

The business be-Quality came Suzuki and success arrived quickly, Martin said. It was largely driven by a popular Suzuki crossover

"Over a few years we became the number one Suzuki dealership in New England," Martin said. "It was like the perfect car for this area. They were small. They were good on gas. They were a crossover. They had push-button four-wheel

But in 2012, Suzuki discontinued sales in the United States. Quality Suzuki subsequently signed an agreement with the company to continue as a Suzuki service center, allowing the dealership to honor warranties on vehicles it had sold.

Thankfully, Martin said, within 30 days of Suzuki's withdrawal, Mitsubishi came calling with a franchise offer. Autosaver Group bit and the dealership's name changed to Quality Mitsubishi.

Mitsubishi offers a vehicle with push-button four-wheel drive similar to the popular Suzuki,

Martin said. Sales continue briskly, she said. Likewise, the dealership's service center is a powerhouse. Martin speculates it's driven by inexpensive oil changes, which cost less than \$20.

"Our oil changes are always on sale," Martin said. "You buy four and you get the fifth one free. You just can't beat that. People love it. It equates to like \$15 an oil change. For \$15 you can't even do an oil change yourself."

The service center provides free car pick-up and drop-off in St. Johnsbury for oil change customers, Martin said.

The service center is furthermore bolstered by the "Big Deal" package of free maintenance for new car buyers. It includes three oil changes, tire rotation twice, and an inspection.

"Most customers after the first year will come back to you," Martin said.

Service center specials run constantly, she said. Coupons are available in the newspaper and online at qualitymitsubishivt.com.

We run specials 52 weeks out of the year," Martin said. Business aside, Martin is proud to be an em-

ployee of Quality Mitsubishi. That's because Autosaver Group, which sells about 1,000 cars a month, maintains a community fund, she said.

Company dealerships on a rotating monthly basis receive a hunk of donation cash. Quality Mitsubishi last month, for example, partnered with a local radio station to donate \$15,000 to local food shelves, including \$5,000 in St. Johnsbury, \$5,000 in Lyndon and \$5,000 in Danville, Martin said.

"It's nice to work with people who raise money for the community," Martin said.

## MAYO'S FURNITURE & FLOORING

ST. JOHNSBURY - Mayo's Furniture & Flooring may be marking its 50th anniversary but owner Fred Laferriere only wants to celebrate his cus-

"This is a great town," Laferriere said. "We have great customer relations. We wouldn't be here if it wasn't for repeat customers. People keep coming back. I can't say enough about the residents of St. Johnsbury and surrounding towns. They're good to us and we take care of them. We offer free delivery within 50 miles and we use all of those miles. We just wouldn't be here today if we didn't have such a good solid customer base.'

The store includes 13,000-square feet of furniture, flooring and window treatments on three

floors within a former grain mill constructed sometime before 1900. Laferriere, the company's second owner, purchased it after first laboring there for 17 vears.

He started at the bot-

"I came here as a carpet and linoleum installer," Laferriere said. "You never know where life is going to take you."

Now he employs 12 people including four full-time floor installers, two floor-store clerks, two furniture deliverymen and four fur-

niture-store clerks. Laferriere is open from 9 a.m. to 5:30 p.m. on Mondays through Saturdays and from 11 a.m. to 5:30 p.m. on Sundays.

Sunday hours are a relatively new addition, and worth the effort. "It has become a big part of our week," Laferriere said. "A lot of times it's the only time that

people can shop. Mayo's specializes in furniture, flooring and window treatments. Big sellers include premium

mattresses, Basset furniture, blinds, and recliners. "We sell tons of recliners," Laferriere said.

He always stocks at least 50 examples. The inventory includes power recliners and sofas equipped with a push button mechanism permitting vast adjustability versus the limited seating positions of levered versions.

Bassett furniture is quite popular as well. Customers have a choice of 1,000 upholstery options sampled on a Mayo's display rack.

Mattress sales are likewise brisk. The trend recently began when Mayo's became a Serta certified America's Mattress store, which delivers access to every model the company manufactures. "A part of the business that has really grown is

the mattresses," Laferriere said. "I think it's because we're an America's Mattress store. We offer everything that Serta offers. Serta is the biggest mattress store in the country. It used to be Sealy, but Serta overtook them."

And bedding ain't what it used to be. The cutting edge is marked by a Serta foam mattress atop an adjustable frame permitting the lifting of head and feet, plus a "zero gravity" position, Laferriere said. Some models feature massage el-

'Everybody loves them," Laferriere said. "People say, 'I can't believe I waited this long in life to be comfortable.' Flooring is another flagship product. The store

includes a nearly 1,000-square foot room dedicated to it. Window treatments like blinds and drapes are

top sellers too. "It is every day that people are in here for that,"

he said.

Mayo's is largely unaffected by the Internet. Laferriere maintains a website mayosfurniture.com, but customers typically prefer to touch furniture before purchasing it.



"You can't try out a mattress or try out a chair on the Internet," he said.

Employee Nancy Hartwell orders the furniture inventory. Three years ago the business began stocking more upscale brands and noticed an immediate increase in sales.

Mayo's now carries 12 brands unavailable anywhere else in the area, she said.

'We have a different group of customers now," Hartwell said. "We have the repeat customers and now we have a lot of the customers from the condo crowd and the lake people.'

The Railroad Street business was founded by resident Mike Mayo five decades ago inside the building that now houses Tim's Deli at the corner of Concord Avenue and Portland Street. He subsequently purchased Sullivan Furniture on Eastern Avenue and moved his business there.

The Eastern Avenue store later burned and in 1978 Mayo bought Curran Furniture on Railroad Street at the present location of Mayo's Furniture & Flooring.

Business specialties included flooring, furniture, glass, and paint. Mayo sold the glass division to Jim Warren 25 years ago, and sold the rest of the business to Laferriere in 1998. Laferriere then sold the paint division to Chad Roy five years ago.

The company has carried several names. It started as Mayo's Paint & Glass, then Mayo's Decorating & Glass, then Mayo's Furniture & Floor Covering, and finally Mayo's Furniture & Floor-





Hayes Ford Owner Says Customers Are The Best Part Of His Business

"It's actually a very exciting business to be in," Hayes said. There are always new models, features and options coming out. "That's the fun part."

But the best part, for Hayes, is getting to know his customers, who come back time and time again when they need new vehicles, auto body service, tires or parts, reconditioning of their vehicles, or

The business, which employs about 30 people, has been in the same location for its entire exis-

The company also holds numerous special events for the community throughout the year. In December, they sponsored the Giving Tree, where employees and community members buy gifts for elders who live in four nursing homes - Maple Lane in Barton, Union House in Glover, and Bel-Aire and Newport Health Care in Newport.

In November, they provided more than 50 complete turkey dinners, which were brought to schools and churches for distribution to those in need. One church, the Church of God, cooks the dinners for people before delivering them, Ricard

The Easter egg hunt was the first community event at Hayes, and the business now offers the Halloween Boo-nanza party with candy and activities for kids.

The business hosts four cruise nights each summer for antique car enthusiasts, and Hayes provides a free barbecue, deejay, and prizes.

When asked why he goes to such lengths for his community, Hayes shrugged and said, "You're supposed to give back to the area that supports

"If people are looking for cars to buy, they're probably going to go where they've been helped,"

Hayes has received numerous awards over the years, but the one that stands out is the President's Award, from the president of Ford himself. He earned that in 1998 and was treated to a gala event in Palm Beach, Florida. When a dealer receives that award, Hayes said, he knows he is in the top echelon of his business.



## **WAYSTACK FRIZZELL** TRIAL LAWYERS

Attorney Leaves The City To Become Top North Country Lawyer 40 Years Later

In January 1975, attorney Philip Waystack decided

that instead of working in Boston, he wanted to strike out on his own.

"I wanted to go where nobody knew my name," Waystack said.

A chance meeting with a judge from Coos County, N.H., drew him to Colebrook, where he opened his own law office and scrambled to get clients.

Forty years later, Waystack Frizzell is a nationallyrecognized defense firm with offices across Coos

Waystack said he had to work on every case when he first started out.

"I really wanted to do trial work," he said, and that meant handing out business cards to anyone who would take them. "I would take every case I got."

Why did he stay in the north? Waystack recalled the frigid morning shortly after he moved to Colebrook when he slid off the road in -23 F conditions. A local pulled him out of the ditch.

He wouldn't accept compensation but he did take Waystack's card.

"As time went on, I realized the people of Colebrook are kind," Waystack said. "They work awfully hard for

That kindness was infectious. Waystack ran for the local school board and felt like a member of the com-

Participating in your community is "one of the hallmarks" that makes a law firm successful, Waystack

"You've gotta give something back."

"I felt like I found my 'tribe'," he said.

Waystack got a break two years into his career in Colebrook as the state-appointed defense attorney in a murder case (in the days before public defenders),

"I'll be damned – I won it." In 1982, he opened his second office in Berlin. He

hired his first associate, Vicki Brunnell, to assist in a high-profile murder case.

Success there led to more expansions.

His first partner was David King, changing the firm's name to Waystack and King. King was appointed to the New Hampshire Supreme Court in 2007. Attorney Jonathan Frizzell, who grew up in Colebrook, joined Waystack in 1996 and became a partner in 2007. His parents are from Colebrook.

The firm changed its name to Waystack Frizzell, Trial Lawyers,

"Jon virtually runs the firm as managing partner,"

Waystack said. Waystack Frizzell has a terrific reputation across

New Hampshire, Frizzell said. In 2011, the firm added an office in Lancaster and added more associates. Now there are six lawyers and

seven staff members. Waystack said his firm specializes in civil court cases, preferring to handle trial work. They might, for example, handle cases of blue collar workers hurt on

the job. "If I have a choice, I try to go to federal court," Waystack said.

In the past few years, Waystack Frizzell has been involved in highly publicized cases, such as representing a woman who lost her husband in the Black Mag explosion case, which was settled in mediation.

Waystack was named "one of the Best Lawyers in America" in 2012-2013 and his firm is on the Super Lawyers' website among the nation's top law firms.

There's been plenty of change in the legal community in Coos County since Waystack arrived in Cole-

Back then, he was the seventh lawyer in Colebrook and the 38th in Coos County.

Now there are only four or five other firms in Coos

County, he noted.

That reflects the creation of state-funded public defenders, and the size of the existing law firms.

## **40 YEARS IN BUSINESS...**

It started 40 years ago as an organization for those living in the most rural areas of the Northeast Kingdom but today Northern Counties Health Care, Inc.

Patrick Flood, has been CEO of Northern Counties Health care since 2013. Prior to that he served the State of Vermont as Commissioner of the Department of Mental Health and prior to that as Deputy Secre-

business with 270 employees and was the first - and now the largest - Federally Qualified Health Center system in Vermont. It's also the only one which also operates a home health care and hospice division. According to its website, the seeds of NCHC began

in 1968 when Caledonia Home Health Care was established under the leadership of local physician Dr. Ralph Jardine and a group of community members interested in the provision of home health care serv-

In 1976, the first Northern Counties Health Centers Board of Directors was formed and established NCHC as the first Federally Qualified Health Center

In 1977, NCHC opened the Hardwick Area Health Center, the Danville Health Center and the Island Pond Health & Dental Center. The Concord Health Center was opened in 1980. In 1981, Caledonia Home Health Care expanded its array of services to include Hospice and Hospice Homemaker services.

In 1988, Caledonia Home Health Care & Hospice and Northern Counties Health Care merged. The Northern Counties Dental Center opened in 2001 and in 2013 Caledonia Internal Medicine and the St. Johnsbury Family Health Center practices joined Northern Counties Health Care, Inc. and formed The St. Johnsbury Community Health Center.

Flood says the future for NCHC presents several challenges for NCHC including a shortage of doctors.

"It's getting harder and harder to attract primary care physicians," said Flood. "It's a big issue."

Other challenges include dealing with growing mental health and substance abuse issues and toward this effort NCHC is already working closely with Northeast Kingdom Human Services.

"We do a lot with addiction," said Flood. "It's a big, big problem.

But the larger picture, said Flood, is to take the existing system that includes NCHC and outside organizations such as NVRH and make it better for patients and more efficient for all.

"Organizationally we're working for better integration so we're working better together so nobody falls though the cracks," said Flood.

Flood began his career as a nurse for seven years during which time he served in a variety of settings including hospitals, psychiatric facilities and elder care settings. Flood retired from employment with the State of Vermont two years ago and assumed his new role as CEO of Northern Counties Health Care, Inc. on Aug. 5, 2013.

"The idea was to make sure low-income residents had access to health care," said Flood. "But we don't serve just low-income Vermonters. Everybody comes

According to information on its website, NCHC provides care to over 18,000 individuals in the Northeast Kingdom through its network of five community health centers, two dental practices, a Medicare-certified home care and hospice division, a comprehensive AIDS/HIV+ care clinic, and a partnership with three different hospitals and many community part-

Services range from preventative care, gynecological care, chronic disease management and behavioral health services to dental care, physical therapy, homemaker services and oncology care coordination. It also provides prenatal, pediatric and adolescent care to adults, geriatrics and end of life care.

Flood says NCHC also works "hand in glove" with Northeastern Vermont Regional Hospital (NVRH), with its doctors and other medical staff sharing work with hospital staff.

"We do a lot of stuff together," said Flood. "They're very cooperative and collaborative." NCHC is a \$19 million dollar a year non-profit



DANVILLE - "I wish I was turning 40," said Marion Cairns, owner of The Creamery Restaurant, which is turning 40 this year.

"It went by fast," Cairns said. "It's probably one of the oldest restaurants owned by the same person in the United States now.' Cairns said the best part of running her business is

the customers, who she said are very loyal. The Creamery specializes in fresh seafood and fish

as well as black Angus beef, Cairns said, which seems to keep both the locals and the summer people staying at camps in Danville happy.

"They become like family," Cairns said.

Speaking of family, at times Cairns has had her brother, mother and sister working for the restaurant. She has also employed multiple generations of local kids.

"I have kids who started working for me who have kids," Cairns said. In some families, the kids of former employees are now employees as well. She employs between 12 and 15 people.

Cairns opened the restaurant in 1976 in a former creamery. She'd enjoyed working in the restaurant business when she was younger and decided opening her own would be a good idea.

Clearly, that idea has panned out.

While the economy has not always been kind. Cairns said she feels very fortunate. "We're seen some real good times and some down times, but mostly good times," she said.

The menu is written on a chalkboard where diners come through the years of business. door, and it changes

nightly. Cairns tries to use as many local ingredients as possible, and the ingredients have to be fresh to pass muster.

"I'm kind of known for my homemade soups," Cairns said.

People also seem to really enjoy the maple cream pie, she said. The pie was formerly made by Cairns mother, Kate Beattie, who passed away last year. Now, her sister Gilly Beattie makes it.

When asked if it is as good as mom's, Cairns said,

"She wouldn't say so, but it is."

In the summer months, the lobster roll with onion rings is very popular.

When asked what she would recommend to diners, Cairns said, "Everybody loves our haddock or our seafood linguine.'

The restaurant seats 40 upstairs, which is often used for special events, and the downstairs seating is a cozy pub atmosphere, she said.

The restaurant doesn't have a ton of reviews online, but the ones there rate the restaurant as a five-star dining establishment.

"The food is delicious, the service is outstanding," wrote Christian Gomes on Google reviews.








ST. JOHNSBURY - Isabelle Armstrong learned about hearing aids, how they worked, how they were serviced, and how to help people with hearing loss for a very personal reason: her mother had hearing loss, and being fitted with devices helped her a great

After raising her family of seven children, Armstrong worked for a hearing aid business in Burlington and learned the trade from a man there. After a few years there, she chose to bring her knowledge

home to St. Johnsbury and open her own business: Armstrong's Better Hearing Service, Ltd.

Now retired, Armstrong, 81, is proud to see the business she opened still in her family's hands. Two of her daughters, Sandra Day and Diane LaRose, purchased the business at 198 Eastern Avenue in St. Johnsbury, from their mother about a decade ago and continue the personal service with the latest developments in technology available for those in need of hearing devices.

The business marks its silver anniversary, 25 years in business, this March, according to the family.

Armstrong's are hearing care professionals, who provide hearing counseling services and hearing aid sales.

The business focuses on hearing aids people can wear for daily life use, "as a person wears glasses for example," the owners said in a brief write-up about their services. The business helps people to make adjustments so the devices work as well as possible for them, and works with manufacturers so that a 90-day trial is provided for customers. That's twice the time required for trials by the State of Vermont, said LaRose and Day.

That the hearing service business is independently-owned means they are able to "take as much or as little time as needed

to service our customers," the business's statement

According to a brief history of the family-owned business, Isabelle Armstrong's mother Flora Sanville Warner, "was the inspiration to getting involved in the hearing industry. Flora was a very vibrant and active lady. As her (hearing) loss worsened, she became less active and social, which was a great loss to us all."

"There was a need for hearing help for her, and many others in the Northeast Kingdom," the history continues. Day and LaRose bought the business from their

mother in 2005.

"It has been very exciting to see the changes in hearing aid technology," according to Armstrong's themselves, plus the aids communicate with each other. Changing the sound in one aid automatically adjusts the other. There are many choices in size, from the totally invisible in-the-canal to larger behind the





## DALTON MOUNTAIN MOTORSPORTS

LANCASTER - Some businesses are born to fill

Dalton Mountain Motorsports - seller of snowmobiles, ATVs and more - did just that, and the region's growing tourist and recreational economy is making it a vital business for years to come.

"We're in the business of fun," said Dalton Mountain Motorsports owner Lisa Nast. "It's an enjoyable experience for someone to come in and buy a toy. It's not like buying a car or refrigerator you have to buy. We sell fun.'

Nast has been with the company since its inception, but became the owner in 2007 after buying it from the family of original owner Dean Walts, who passed away in 2006.

Walts had founded and owned the Dalton Mountain Motors car dealership next door. He then decided to expand and constructed the Dalton Mountain Motorsports building in 2001 at the north end of Lancaster, at 475 Main Street.

Today, its new and pre-owned product lines include Suzuki motorcycles, ATVs and outboards, Bombardier ATVs, Ski-doo snowmobiles, Sea-doo personal watercraft and sports boats, Johnson outboards, Crestliner boats, and Stingray boats.

Also sold are Can-Am ATVs, Spider motorcycles (the ones with two front wheels and one rear wheel), pontoon boats, snowblowers and chain-

"In the North Country, you have to do a little bit of everything to stay alive," said Nast.

In its first year, Dalton Mountain Motorsports was named N.H. Snowmobile Association dealer

thinking of buying," said Nast.

Customers come from near and far. We have a nice local base of customers and also have a lot of second-home people who come up to snowmobile and who have been customers for years," said Nast. "It's a good core base of people."

Depending on the year, anywhere from 150 to 225 snowmobiles are sold.

But the ATV line is catching up.

"The ATV and side-by-sides are growing," said Nast. "They are not where the snowmobiles are, because the trail system is in its infancy, but I think they will become as popular as snowmobiles."

A growing number of Coos County ATV organizations in the North Country OHRV Coalition are leading the charge for more trails, and are working to expand Ride The Wilds, the Northeast's largest interconnected ATV trail system, with more than 1,000 miles of trails across Coos.

"We are very involved," said Nast. "It's not just for our business, but it's good for the economy in general. We don't have the mills any more, we don't have the things we used to have, and tourism is the thing we need to focus on."

Dalton Mountain Motorsports, employing a staff of nine, is open seven days a week during winter and Monday through Saturday during summers.

"We enjoy being in a position where we can make things happen for people," said Nast.
