

St. Johnsbury Kiwanis Pool Capital Campaign



St. Johnsbury's Kiwanis Pool was built by St. Johnsbury Kiwanis and opened in 1944. The pool has been owned, operated, and maintained by St. Johnsbury Kiwanis for 82 years, offering Red Cross swimming lessons and swimming to St. Johnsbury area youth, families, and seniors at no cost. In recent years, the pool has undergone several upgrades, including new diving boards, a slide, pumps, control and chlorination systems, a pool deck, fencing, and rehabilitation and repair of above and below-grade piping. These expenses have totaled about \$350,000 and have been paid for by St. Johnsbury Kiwanis. **In order for the pool to reopen in the summer of 2026, significant long-term repairs to the pool basin must be completed to stop leakage and erosion.** This project includes sand-blasting the pool, concrete repair, professional painting and sealing, seam replacement, and new circulation piping. The estimated total cost of these repairs and a reserve replenishment is \$453,000. These repairs will secure the pool for the next 20-30 years.
