Chagrin Falls Referendum on Ordinance No. 2021-24

Shall Ordinance No. 2021-24 of the Village of Chagrin Falls amending the Planning and Zoning Code Section 1135.02(a)(1) to permit limited retail sales or services within office buildings, and to further amend Section 1135.02 (a)(1) to add a new subsection (B) to limit the amount of retail sales or retail services permitted in multi-tenant office buildings be adopted?

Claridon Township Streets, Roads, Bridges - Add'1 1.76 mills, 5 years

A majority affirmative vote is necessary for passage. An additional tax for the benefit of Claridon Township excluding Aquilla Village for the purpose of general construction, reconstruction, resurfacing and repair of streets, roads and bridges at a rate not exceeding 1.76 mills for each one dollar of valuation, which amounts to \$0.176 for each one hundred dollars of valuation, for 5 years, commencing in 2022, first due in calendar year 2023.

Chardon Township Streets, Roads, Bridges - Add'1 2.75 mills, 5 yrs

A majority affirmative vote is necessary for passage. An additional tax for the benefit of Chardon Township for the purpose of general construction, reconstruction, resurfacing, and repair of streets, roads, and bridges at a rate not exceeding 2.75 mills for each one dollar of valuation, which amounts to \$0.275 for each one hundred dollars of valuation, for 5 years, commencing in 2022, first due in 2023.
