Citrus County School District Corrects Millage Rate Error on 2026 TRIM Notices

CITRUS COUNTY, Fla. — Citrus County property owners will receive a corrective notice of proposed property taxes addressing an incorrect millage rate for the Citrus County School District that appeared on the 2026 Notice of Proposed Property Taxes, also known as the TRIM Notice, previously mailed to them.

Once the district was notified of the error by the state, Superintendent Scott Hebert immediately contacted Citrus County Property Appraiser, Cregg Dalton, to determine the steps necessary to correct the information and notify Citrus County taxpayers. For most property owners, the correction will result in a very small change. The difference amounts to about **\$0.70 cents for every \$100,000 of taxable value.**

The error occurred during the district's calculation process. After receiving the applicable millage information from the state, an additional required millage component was inadvertently omitted from the rate certified by the district. The district is reviewing its internal procedures and adding additional verification steps to help prevent a similar error in the future.
