CORRECTIVE NOTICE OF PROPOSED PROPERTY TAXES

Correction of School District State Law Millage Rate

Dear Property Owner:

The 2026 Notice of Proposed Property Taxes (TRIM Notice) previously mailed to you contained an incorrect State Law millage rate for the Citrus County School District. This resulted from an error by the Citrus County School District in determining the State Law millage rate certified to the Citrus County Property Appraiser for inclusion on the TRIM Notice. This correction notice is being provided to notify you of the corrected rate. **Your property values, exemptions, classifications, and taxable values have not changed.**

Corrected School District State Law Millage

Item	Millage Rate
Rate shown on original TRIM Notice	3.087
Correct proposed rate	3.094
Difference	+0.007

The rate that is being corrected is found on your TRIM notice, Column 5, as “SCHOOLS – LOCAL REQ'D EFFORT”

How this affects proposed taxes. A difference of 0.007 mills equals \$0.007 of additional proposed tax for each \$1,000 of School District taxable value. The additional proposed tax can be estimated as:

$$\text{School District Taxable Value} \times 0.000007 = \text{Additional Proposed School Tax}$$

Examples

School District Taxable Value	Additional Proposed Tax
\$100,000	\$0.70
\$200,000	\$1.40
\$300,000	\$2.10
\$500,000	\$3.50
\$1,000,000	\$7.00

Use the School District taxable value shown on your original TRIM Notice when estimating the effect of this correction. No other information on your previously mailed notice is changed by this correction.

Statutory basis: Section 200.065(14), Florida Statutes, permits a Department of Revenue-approved short-form correction notice for qualifying errors on a previously mailed notice.
