Whereas *Andrew K. Ruff of Hernando County Florida*

has deposited in the GENERAL LAND OFFICE of the United States, a Certificate of THE REGISTER OF THE LAND OFFICE at *Gainesville Florida* whereby it appears that full payment has been made by the said *Andrew K. Ruff*

according to the provisions of the

Act of Congress of the 24th of April, 1820, entitled "An act making further provision for the sale of the Public Lands," for and the acts supplemental thereto, for the lots numbered one and two, and the north-east quarter of the north-west quarter of section eighteen in township nineteen south of range twenty east, of Tallahassee Meridian in Florida containing one hundred and fifty four acres and seventy six hundredths of an acre

according to the official plat of the Survey of the said Lands, returned to the General Land Office by the SURVEYOR GENERAL, which said tract has been purchased by the said *Andrew K. Ruff*

NOW KNOW YE, That the

United States of America, in consideration of the premises, and in conformity with the several acts of Congress in such case made and provided, HAVE GIVEN AND GRANTED, and by these presents DO GIVE AND GRANT, unto the said *Andrew K. Ruff*

and to *his* heirs, the said tract above described: To have and to hold the same, together with all the rights, privileges, immunities, and appurtenances, of whatsoever nature, thereunto belonging, unto the said *Andrew K. Ruff*

and to *his* heirs and assigns forever.
