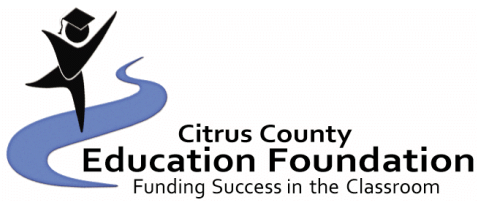

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Procedures:

1. All applications must be typed or computer-generated and complete.
2. All applications must be returned **NO LATER** than April 2nd, 2021 to:

3. The recipient will be announced at the high school academic awards programs.
4. The monetary award will be forwarded to the selected post-secondary institution upon documentation (student ID and proof of registered classes) obtained by the student from the school that the recipient is currently enrolled in. The awardee must use scholarship funds for tuition, required educational institution fees, and/or other direct course-related expenses required of all students enrolled in during instruction.
5. Applicant must **NOT** be Directors, employees, or family members of Directors or employees of Suncoast Credit Union, Members Title Company, Members Insurance Services, Members Trust Company or Suncoast Realty Solutions LLC.

Criteria Checklist:

1. ___ The applicant must be a Citrus County resident of at least one year.
2. ___ The applicant must be a graduating senior student, be enrolled in accredited 4-year college/university, 2-year college or technical school in Florida, and begin his/her post-secondary school in 2021-2022 academic year
3. ___ Grades: The transcript of the applicant must be submitted. The transcript must include the current GPA and SAT/ACT scores. Students should have taken academically rigorous courses, and must have earned a least a 3.0 GPA.
4. ___ Leadership Activities: Students must also demonstrate leadership in extracurricular activities.
5. ___ Community Involvement: List all contributions to the community and/or work and/or volunteer experience. Evidence of involvement in community activities may help to document a student's leadership skills.
6. ___ References:
 - a. Two (2) letters of reference are required.
 - b. References may come from a teacher, advisor, guidance counselor, school administrator, employer, clergy, a person with whom the student has done volunteer or community work, or any other adult who is aware of the student's leadership skills.
7. ___ Essay (300 words or less): Each applicant must write an essay explaining why the student is seeking this scholarship, why the student wants to attend college, major, the student's financial need and the student's goals for the future.
