Electric

- Electric service is delivered to customers using a redundant transmission and distribution system consisting of 11 substations and 340 miles of line.
- Operations are monitored remotely by SCADA to insure high reliability and fast response to a diverse residential, business and manufacturing sector.
- Services provided include security lighting, street lighting, traffic controls and power quality monitoring to industry.

Water/Wastewater

- The Roy S. Oakes Water Treatment Plant has a capacity of 24 million gallons per day and has exceeded all standards established by the Tennessee Department of Environment of Conservation. Water Treatment process is a conventional mix media filtration plus water is treated through a deep bed granular activated carbon contactor.
- Water Distribution System has provided Insurance Service Organization Class 3 water supply rating for the past 20 years.
- Wastewater System has 2 Wastewater Treatment Plants, 30 Pumping Stations, and over 275 miles of collection system mains. Major renovations have been and are being performed to maintain TDEC compliance.

Telecommunications

- Fiber to the Premise (FTTP), serving commercial, industrial, and residential locations in Morristown and Hamblen County for video, Internet, and voice.
- A local Network Operations Center providing 24/7 network monitoring and support.
- FiberNet provides local sales, service, and technical support.


