Electricity

- LCEC is beginning to restore power. Please be patient. Power will be coming to your neighborhood.
- Areas with water intrusion should be monitored. Salt water and wiring do not mix. Be cautious.

Municipal Water

- There is NO boil water order on Marco Island
- Water & Sewer services are intact throughout the City.

Road Conditions

- All primary roads and bridges on Marco Island are open and passable.
- Please stay off the streets as much as possible.
- Do not drive through standing water.

Cooling & Charging Center – Mackle Park, 8am -7 p.m.

- Those without electricity are welcome to cool-down and charge their mobile devices at the Mackle Park 1361 Andalusia Terrace (open 8 a.m. - 7 p.m.).

Need to contact a family member?

- Residents who have an urgent need to call a family member to inform them of their health and well-being can access a phone for this purpose – ***no more than 2 minutes***. Mackle Park 1361 Andalusia Terrace (open 8am - 7pm)

Storm Debris Collection

- Curbside debris collection is scheduled to begin on Mon., Oct 3.
- Please separate all storm litter and debris into piles for when services return
 - Normal Trash
 - Vegetative Debris

- Construction Debris
- Appliances and white goods
- Electronics
- Hazardous Waste

Grocery Stores

- Publix (both Marco locations) are open for business.
- Winn-Dixie is open for business (including pharmacy)

Fuel/Gas Stations

- Currently, there are no gas stations open on Marco Island. Please refrain from unnecessary driving.

Boats – Lost or found

- To report a lost or found boat call (239) 389-5050 or report at the lobby of the Police Dept., 8am – 5-pm, or via direct message to the Marco Island Police Dept on their social media page.

No Boating and/or Personal Watercraft Use

- All boating and personal watercraft use on Marco Waterways is prohibited due to hazardous conditions.
- Assessment of waterways is ongoing.

Abandoned /Towed Vehicles

- To retrieve a towed motor vehicle, call Executive Auto, (239) 642-0003

Generators

- Generators should be placed in a well-ventilated area at least 20 feet from structures
- Be sure to check the specifications for limitations for your specific generator
- Never fuel generator while running

Scams

- Be aware of unlicensed contractors who offer to do work in your home. Use licensed contractors only.
