The Delaware Department of Transportation (DelDOT) invites residents, businesses, freight industry representatives, local governments, community organizations, and other interested stakeholders to attend a public workshop on the **2026 Draft Delaware State Freight Plan**.

The State Freight Plan serves as Delaware's roadmap for improving the movement of goods throughout the state by truck, rail, air, and maritime transportation. The plan identifies freight transportation needs, opportunities, and investment priorities that support economic growth, supply chain reliability, safety, mobility, and environmental sustainability. The 2026 update is being developed in partnership with regional planning organizations and stakeholders across Delaware.

Workshop Purpose

The public workshop will provide an opportunity for attendees to:

- Learn about the goals, findings, and recommendations of the Draft 2026 Delaware State Freight Plan.
- Review proposed freight transportation priorities and strategies.
- Discuss freight-related opportunities and challenges affecting Delaware communities and businesses.
- Provide comments and feedback that will help shape the final plan.
