

Town Municipal Services Budget:

The proposed FY27 municipal services budget would result in an estimated 6.6% increase to municipal services property taxes. This budget accounts for planned expenditures for maintaining our current level of Town services, and addresses additional resource needs for: 1) paid on-call

staffing for the Fire Department; 2) increases in salary, benefits & training for the Police Department; 4) increases in salary, benefits and training for the Rescue Department; 5) increased costs for necessary software for Information Technology (IT).

Forty-two percent, or \$7,967,487 of the FY27 Municipal Services budget is dedicated to the Town's public safety services – Police, Fire, Rescue, Technical Rescue, and Public Safety Dispatch. This amount doesn't include the other municipal support services provided for public safety equipment, vehicle/building maintenance, information technology, human resources, finance/payroll, and general management needs. With those costs included, the public safety services would represent well over half of our municipal services budget.

For a property with an assessed value of \$300,000, the estimated increase in FY27 municipal services property taxes would be \$134 compared to the current year.

A Message from VTrans: Exit 16 Construction Update

TRAFFIC IMPACT AND DURATION: From Monday, January 5, through Friday, January 9, between 7 AM and 3 PM, lane closures and lane shifts will be in place on Lower Mountain View Drive and Upper Mountain View Drive near their intersection with U.S. Routes 2/7 (U.S. 2/7). A lane closure and shift will also be in effect on the west side of U.S. 2/7 just south of Rathe Road.



Independent utility companies will periodically be on-site conducting utility work along U.S. 2/7 between the Winooski town line and Sunderland Woods Road under lane closures.

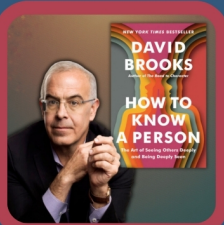

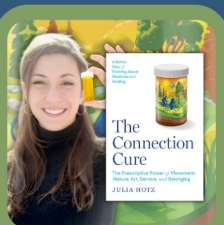
